

Minutes of the Meeting of the State Highway
Commission of Virginia, Held in
Tazewell, Virginia, August
27th, 1931.

On the morning of August 27th, 1931, the State Highway Commission of Virginia, consisting of Messrs. H. G. Shirley, Commissioner, Wade H. Massie, Secretary, H. G. Gilmer, and Wm. H. East, met at Tazewell, Virginia.

The meeting was called to order by the Commissioner.

Moved by Mr. East, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that the contract for the construction of Project F640-A1, Route 33, 0.14 Mile N. Roanoke-NCL Roanoke, be awarded to the low bidder, J. R. Vaughan & Co., Roanoke, Va., at their bid of \$3,494.36, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, and \$388.65 for surface treatment, making a total of approximately \$5,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. East, that the contract for the construction of Project S173-B1, Route 31, Bridge over Kingsland Creek, be awarded to the low bidder, Perkins-Barnes Construction Company, Blackstone, Va., at their bid of \$2,118.50, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$2400.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Massie, that contract for the construction of Project F826-AB, Route 40, Deep Creek-N.C. Line, be awarded to the low bidder, Robert Martin Co. Inc., Salem, Va., at their bid of \$110,308.88, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, and \$22,020.10 for surface treatment, making a total of approximately \$144,000.00 chargeable to this project, with the understanding that the contract be to the extent of \$100,000.00 allocation for all purposes. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the State Highway Commission cooperate with the State Road Commission of West Virginia, and construct the portion of Route 834, West Virginia's Route 23, that is in Virginia between Capon Springs and Highview. Motion carried.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned, subject to the call of the Commissioner.
