Minutes of the Meeting of the State Highway Commission of Virginia, Held in Taxewell, Virginia, August 27th, 1951.

On the morning of Angust 27th, 1931, the State Highway Commission of Virginia, consisting of Mesers. H. G. Shirley, Commissioner, Unde H. Massie, Secretary, H. G. Cilmer, and Mr. H. East, not at Taxorell, Virginia.

The meeting was called to order by the Commissioner.

Moved by Mr. Bast, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that the contract for the construction of Project F640-Al, Route 35, O.14 Mile M. Roanoke-MCL Roanoke, be awarded to the low bidder, J. R. Vaughan & Co., Roanoke, Va., at their hid of \$3,404.55, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, and \$393.65 for surface treatment, making a total of approximately \$5,000,00 chargeable to this project. Notion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massle, seconded by Mr. East, that the contract for the construction of Project 6175-B1, Houte 31, Bridge over Ringsland Creek, be awarded to the low bidder, Perkins-Barnes Construction Company, Blackstone, Va., at their bid of \$2,118.50, and that 10% additional be set uside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$2400.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Massie, that contract for the construction of Project P826-AB, Route 40, Deep Creek-B.C.Line, be swarded to the low bidder, Robert Martin Co. Inc., Salem, Va., at their bid of \$110,308.88, and that 10% additional he sat aside to over the cost of engineering and additional work, and \$22,020.10 for surface treatment, making a total of approximately \$144,000.00 chargeable to this project, with the understanding that the contract be to the extent of \$100,000.00 ellocation for all purposes. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the State Highway Commission cooperate with the State Road Commission of West Virginia, and construct the portion of Route 834, West Virginia's Route 23, that is in Virginia between Capon Springs and Fighview. Motion carried.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned, subject to the call of the Commissioner.
