

**Minutes of the Meeting of the State Highway
Commission of Virginia, Held in
Richmond, August 4, 1932.**

On the morning of August 4th, 1932, the State Highway Commission, consisting of Messrs. H. G. Shirley, Wade H. Massie, Secretary, L. White Truxton, H. G. Gilmer, and Wm. H. East, met in their office, State Office Building, Richmond, Virginia.

The meeting was called to order by the Commissioner.

Moved by Mr. Truxton, seconded by Mr. East, that the minutes of the meeting of July 15th, be approved. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Truxton, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the minutes of the meeting of July 19th be approved. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that the petition of Ray Hamon, et alis, for opening a 30 ft. road and building a bridge in Shenandoah County, beginning at the Forestville North Mountain road at J. D. Galladay's and to state road at intersection of road leading to Buck Hill, as an addition to the Secondary System, be rejected. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. East, that permit #10158, Norfolk County, issued July 22nd to the Portsmouth Gas Company, be cancelled, as requested by this company. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Truxton, that concerning claim No. 88, for hospital and medical service rendered J. S. Deane, the Commission is willing to make the following payments in lieu of all claims,

and further that the various hospitals be requested to give a rate for hospital services to injured employees. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. East, that on the Secondary System of Roads where there are gates, they be shaped up in the spring and fall and no additional maintenance be done except in emergencies, such as the washout of culverts and bridges, as long as the gates remain. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Truxton, that at the request of the Governor, the State Highway Commission agrees to divert \$200,000.00 of the 1931-32 funds to the general funds of the State to avoid a deficit or cut in all other appropriations. Motion carried. Mr. Shirley not voting.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. East, that the Commission agree to stand a \$4,000.00 deficit in the Treasurer's office for postage used on State Highway mail. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. East, that the following roads be accepted into the Secondary System in Norfolk County -

Riverside Drive, from Franklin Street to Western Branch Boulevard.

Orange Street, from Shenandoah Street northwest to Western Branch Boulevard. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. East, that the following roads be rejected for addition to the Secondary System in Norfolk County -

Gillis Road, proposed addition 0.45 mile.

Grayson Street, from intersection of Shenandoah Street, northeast to intersection of Remond Street. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Hazzie, seconded by Mr. East, that the allocations confirmed on the 29th of July, be amended as follows to take care of the \$300,000.00 fund diverted to the general treasury -
