

**Minutes of the Meeting of the
State Highway Commission of Virginia, Held in
Richmond, August 4, 1938.**

On the morning of August 4th, the State Highway Commission, consisting of Messrs. H. G. Shirley, Wade H. Massie, Secretary, I. Walks Truxton, H. G. Gilmer and Wm. H. East, met in their office, State Office Building, Richmond, Virginia.

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. East, that the minutes of the meeting of May 18th be approved. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. East, that the minutes of the meeting of June 21st be approved. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. East, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that the minutes of the meeting of June 29th be approved. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. East, that the State Highway Commission cooperate with the President in carrying out the National Recovery Act, so far as the State laws will permit. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Truxton, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that the request of Miss Bessie L. Luake, for the payment of half of her salary, (\$45.00 per month) be granted for her three months furlough beginning July 28, 1938. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. East, that the request of Mr. H. J. Neale for extension of sick leave, be not granted, in view of the fact that it is the opinion of the Commission his salary should be sufficient to take care of his needs. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the Chairman be instructed to prepare bill to be introduced in Congress providing the necessary right of way on Route 1, (old Route 31) in Fairfax and Prince William Counties, from the northern boundary of Fort Humphries Reservation to Stafford County Line. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. East, that the request of Roanoke City that the State pay part of the cost of hangar for airport, be not granted. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that the following permits be approved under the rules and regulations of the Commission:

Motion carried.

Motion carried.

North Fork of Shenandoah River-0.11 Mi. S. North Fork of Shenandoah River, to the low bidder, Echols Bros., Inc., Staunton, Va., at their bid of \$4,208.85, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work; \$500.00 for detours; \$68.00 for guard rail; \$56.25 for outside slope stakes and \$588.57 for surface treatment, making a total of approximately \$7,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. East, seconded by Mr. Iruxtun, that the Commission confirm award of contract for the construction of Project F555 H4, Route 5, old Route 41, Bridge over Mechu Creek, to the low bidder, Boston Construction Co. Inc., South Boston, Va., at their bid of \$11,388.95, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$13,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the Commission confirm rejection of all bids on Project F162 B5, Route 1, old Route 31, Bridge over Quantico Creek, and do the work by force account. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. East, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the Commission confirm rejection of all bids on Project F585 L1, Route 5, old Route 41, 6.7 Mi. E. Shadwell-Shadwell, and do the work by force account. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. East, seconded by Mr. Massie, that contract for the construction of Route 58, old Route 44, Project F752 B41, Bridge and Approaches to Dan River, be awarded to the low bidder, F. M. Arthur, South Boston, Va., at his bid of \$28,051.57, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work; \$15.05 for soil rights; \$65.00 for guard rail; and \$118.50 for surface treatment, making a total of approximately \$28,000.00 chargeable to this project, subject to securing rights of way. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Traxton, that contract for the construction of Route 11, old Route 10, Project F261 A1 51-503J, Mariam-West, be awarded to the low bidder, Walters and Prater, Gasburn, Va., at their bid of \$48,488.11, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work; \$1,072.50 for guard rail; \$4,892.68 for surface treatment, and \$1,871.00 for outside slope stakes, making a total of approximately \$53,000.00 chargeable to this project, subject to securing rights of way. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that the request of J. F. McGuire for an extension of time on Project F20 AW, BW, B41, Route 12, WCL Franklin-7.8 Mi. W. WCL Franklin, new Route 58, be granted for 30 days and return \$500.00 liquidated damages, as recommended by the Chief Engineer. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that the request of Tunstall Johnson Company for an extension of time on Project F707B, Route 205, old Route 811, Bridge over Tide Mill Stream, be granted for 11 days and \$110.00 liquidated damages returned, as recommended by the Chief Engineer. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that the request of J. S. Bowers for an extension of time on Project F515 E2, Route 11, old Route 10, Bridge over North Fork Holston River, be granted for 19 days and \$190.00 liquidated damages returned, as recommended by the Chief Engineer. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. East, that the request of James Cain and Co., Amherst, Va., for return of liquidated damages on Project F555 C81, Route 80, old Route 13, 0.21 Mi. E. Pedlar River-Rockbridge County Line, be approved to the extent of \$450.00 being returned, as recommended by the Chief Engineer. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that the request of Mr. Chas. W. Crush, Commonwealth's Attorney of Montgomery County, be held in abeyance concerning the R&E Overhead Crossing on Route 6, old Route 25, in Christiansburg. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that the Town of Salem be given \$15,000.00 of the Federal funds appropriated for municipalities in the Salem District. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Mascie, that \$500.00 per mile additional be given the City of Winchester for the year 1933-34 to cover the work outlined in letter of June 18th from the City Manager. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Truxtun, that the best terms possible be made to settle damage claim for right of way on Route 23, new Route 8, Project 461, Rich Creek-West Virginia Line, not exceeding \$8,000.00. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Truxtun, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that the allocation of funds to the secondary system be confirmed as follows, for the year beginning July 1, 1933 and ending June 30, 1934.
