Whereas it is contemplated by the State Commission on Conservation and Development to transfer and convey to the United States of America all right, title and interest which said Commission and the Commonwealth of Virginia have or may hereafter acquire in and to certain lands known as and constituting Richmond Battlefield Parks, pursuant to chapter 285 Acts of the General Assembly 1954; and whereas that portion of State Highway Route number 156 (formerly 414) from its junction with Route 5 (formerly 41) to the highway known as Osborne turnpike, is within the boundaries of the area known as Richmond Sattlefield Parks in Henrico County, and it is desired that this roadbed be transferred to the United States of America at the same time that the other lands comprising said Richmond Battlefield Parks are so transferred and conveyed; and whereas the land in said readled was conveyed to the Commonwealth of Vir ginia by deeds from the Richmond Battlefields Park Corporation for highway purposes; and whereas during the year 1930 said road was incorporated into the State Highway System and has been maintained as a part of said system ever since; and whereas it is deceed by the Chairman of the Highway Commission that when said Richmond Battlefield Parks area is transferred to the United States of America said road will be no longer necessary as a part of the State Highway Systems

Ecw, therefore, be it resolved that that portion of the State Righway Houte 156 (formerly 414) from its junction with Route 5 (formerly 41) to the highway known as the Caborne Turnpike be abandoned as a part of the State Righway System and the same be deleted from the State Righway System, and the Chairman of the State Righway Commission is hereby authorized and directed to discontinue the maintenance of the same. Provided, however, such abandonnent, deletion and discontinuance of maintenance shall not be effective until at such time the said area known as the Richmond Sattlefield Perks, including the said roadway (pertion of Route 156) is transferred and conveyed to the United States of America by the State Commission on Conservation and Development by deed in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 286 Acts of the General Assembly (Va.) 1934. Motion carried.

Whereas in July, 1956, this Commission obtained from Comp Name turing Company permission to remove the railroad crossing teach across State Righmay No. 58 at a point in Isle of Wight County a few feet cost of the Blackmater River in return for an agreement by this Commission that said track may be replaced at any time the Company sees fit, and said track has accordingly been removed:
