

Minutes of the Meeting of the State Highway  
Commission of Virginia, Held in  
Richmond, August 26, 1937.

On the morning of August 26th, the State Highway Commission, consisting of Messrs. H. G. Shirley, Wade H. Massie, Secretary, Wm. H. East, S. W. Rawls and J. F. Wyser, met in their office, State Office Building, Richmond, Va.

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman.

Moved by Mr. Wyser, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the minutes of the meeting of July 28th be approved. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Wyser, seconded by Mr. Rawls, that the sick leave of S. T. Mitchell, Junior Operator, be extended from July 12th to 17th inclusive, with pay. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the sick leave of R. W. Sorrells, Junior Foreman, be extended one month with pay. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Rawls, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the sick leaves of E.L. Beadles, Senior Mechanic, be extended from July 21st to August 18th inclusive, with pay. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. East, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the sick leave of G. W. Swarts, Senior Mechanic, be extended from July 21st to August 18th inclusive, with pay. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. East, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that the request for a survey around Cozyway Robinson Memorial Park be tabled. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. East, seconded by Mr. Rawls, that the addition and abandonment recommended in Augusta County Secondary system be passed by and no action taken. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the location of Route 11 from Lexington-South be along the line east of the present road. Motion carried.
