S. Moved by Mr. Watkins, seconded by Senator Nelson, that WHEREAS, in the vicinity of McLean in Fairfax County, it has been determined by the engineers of the Highway Department, that for all intents and purposes traffic on Route 125 has for some time been following the short out-off over Route 1820 and that the Route markers should properly be reversed; ROW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESCRIVED, that the following transfers between the State Highway Systems as shown on sketch dated June 8, 1958, be immediately effected; AND TO THE HAIMARY SYSTEM BY THANSFER FROM THE SECONDARY SYSTEM (Section 55-26 of the 1850 Code of Virginia) Route 1820, from its intersection with present Route 125 north 0.50 mile to its intersection again with present Route 125. Length 0.50 Mile. DELETE FROM THE PRIMARY SYSTEM BY TRANSFER TO THE SECONDARY SYSTEM (Section 58-27 of the 1950 Code of Virginia) Route 125, from its intersection with Route 1820 northerly 0.35 mile to its intersection again with Route 1820. Length 0.85 Mile. Motion carried.

Hoved by Mr. Rawle, seconded by Senator Nelson, that WEEREAS, the Department is losing the services of many good college and high school graduates due to our strict policy covering nepoties, and WEEREAS, with the increased highway program the competition is been in recruiting personnel, and WEEREAS, we must increase our forces by recruitment and training of these pactuits for technical positions; NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESEAVED, that during this emergency our policy be released to permit employment of persons who are qualified to hold technical positions, such as college, preparatory school and high school graduates who will be employed as trainees for technical positions. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. May, seconded by Mr. Watkins, that WHERRAS, by proper resolutions the various Boards of Supervisors have requested the discontinuance of certain roads in the Secondary System; and whereas the Resident Engineers representing the Commission, did post notices and hold bearings in the respective counties to ascertain whether or not such roads should be discontinued, the proposed discontinuances meeting no valid opposition, now therefore, be it resolved, that the following roads be discontinued as parts of the Secondary System as provided by Section 53-76.7 of the 1950 Code of Virginia, as smended; effective this date EUSSELL COUNTY - Section 1 of old location of Route 645, between Station 115/60, Project 1583-11. Length 0.06 Mile

Section 2 of cld location of Route 645, between Station 152/65 and Station 155/60, Project 1585-11. Length 0.07 Mile BEDFORD COUNTY - Section 1 of old location of Route 645, between Station 219/90 and Station 222/80, Project 1509-15. Length 0.15 Mile NING GEORGE COUNTY - Section 1 of old location of Route 608, between Station 37/00 and Station 45/25, Project 1548-10. Length 0.16 Mile. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. May, seconded by Mr. Rawls, that WHEREAS, in a resolution adopted by the Council of the City of Roanoke at its meeting on July 16, 1956, it is requested of the State Highway Constanton to name the new Jefferson Street Grede Crossing Elimination Bridge in memory of the late Williams Pearce Hunter, who served with distinction as Roanoke's first City Manager from the 1st day of Outober, 1916 through the Sist day of December, 1947, and WHEREAS, the City of Roanoke agrees to pay the cost and expense in connection theretith, including the cost of streeting appropriate plaques, and WHEREAS, under authority of Section 55-175 of the 1950 Gode of Virginia the State Righway Commission is given authority to name Bridges constructed on the Primary System, MOW, THEREFORE, HE IT RESOLVED, that this Commission confer the name "Milliams Pearce Hunter" upon the new bridge over the Morfolk and Western Railroad, designated on Route 11 (North Jefferson Street) in the City of Roanoke. Motion carried,

Moved by Mr. May, seconded by Mr. Rawls, that as provided under Article 6.1, Section 53-76.5 of the 1950 Code of Virginia, as smeaded, and upon recommendation of the Commissionar, the following sections of old Route 501 in Bedford County, being no longer necessary for uses as a highest, they be shandowed to the extent of alteration: Sections 1, 2 and 5 shown on plat dated September 9, 1955, Project 2009-05. Further, as provided under Article 2, Section 55-27 of the said Code Section 4 shown on the plat referred to be transferred from the Primary to the Secondary System. Motion carried,

Moved by Mr. Rawle, seconded by Mr. Flythe, that the Commission satherise a Capital Outlay appropriation of \$811,000.00 to cover the first year of a three year program for additions to office buildings, soils laboratories, etc., as outlined in letters of August 6, 1958, to General Anderson from Mr. Felix and Mr. Eures the cost to be carried until the end of the present fiscal year as an authorised deficit. It is expected that this will be covered by surplus collections for the current fiscal year. Otherwise it will be carried by the 1957-58 allocations. Notice carried.

Moved by Mr. Flythe, seconded by Mr. Barrow, that WHEREAS, the Highway Commission by resolution requires retirement of its employees at 70 years of age and does not request continued employees retiring each year with many years of State service, and WHEREAS, where it has been determined by the Division of Organization & Public Relations, that these retiring employees have lost earned annual leave, have worked many Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays and have not been permitted to take vecation equal to the rest days they have worked, therefore HE IT RESOLVED, that upon retirement these employees be given, as separation pay, their earned accumulated annual leave plus compensatory leave, not to exceed seven days, in appreciation of their loyalty to the Highway Department and their service to the Commonwealth above and beyond the regular call of duty. Motion carried.

The Chairman explained the conflict in provisions of Chapter 451 and Chapter 716 of the Acts of the Assembly of 1956 as they affect the per diem rate for Commission members, and the steps being taken to correct this.

The Chairman advised that a satisfactory compromise had been reached with the City of Hampton in connection with the Hampton Roads Bridge-Tunnel Project.

Moved by Mr. Rawls, seconded by Mr. Flythe, that the "long line" be adopted on the south approach of the Harrisonburg by-pass. Motion carried

After a brief statement by the Chief Engineer, the Commission left on a trip over Routes 501 and 1 to the North Carolina Line and return. This trip was planned to acquaint the Commission members with the problems to be considered in getting under way the program on the Interstate System.

On Friday, August 10, the Commission met in the Central Office at 9:00 A.M.

Moved by Mr. May, seconded by Mr. Watkins, that the Commission award contract on the Hampton Roads Project - Contract B-lA, on hids received August 8, 1958, to the low bidder, George M. Brewster & Son., Inc., Bogota, H. J., at the bid of \$2,977,820.71, chargeable to the Bevenue Bond Act Funds. Motion carried.

A report on the progress of the VALC study was given by Mr. Eure, Fiscal Director.

Mr. F. A. Davis, Chief Engineer, discussed the laws and standards on the Interstate System, and the subject of finances of the Interstate System was discussed by Mr. Davis, Mr. Eure and Mr. D. B. LaPrade.

Mr. LaProde presented a series of slides, with recorded equants, on "Planned Access."

At 10:15 A.M. a hearing was held on a requested new road between Harrisonburg and Charlottesville, "Copy of original statement presented to the Chairman on June 21, 1956, by a special committee of the Harrisonburg Rockinghan Chamber of Commerce and group from Grottees, and Charlottesvillet "copy of resolution adopted August 6, 1956, by the Rockinghan County Board of Supervisors, the Harrisonburg City Council and Harrisonburg-Rockinghan Chamber of Commerce"; and excerpt from minutes of meeting of the Rockinghan Chamber of Supervisors held on August 6, 1956; letter of Mr. H. P. Snapp, Clark, Town of Grottees, quoting resolution adopted by the Town Council of Grottees; and letter of August 9, 1956, from Dr. O. F. Foley, Chairman of the Highway Countities of Harrisonburg-Rockingham Chamber of Commerce, were presented.

R. L. Stults, Executive Secretary of Harrisonburg-Rockingham Chamber of Commerce; B. S. McKay, Chairman of the Board of Supervisors of Rockingham County; H. P. Shapp, Clerk, Town of Grottoes; T. R. Cooley and Dave Clarke, City Planning Engineer of Harrisonburg; Supervisor Long of Augusta County; W. S. Campbell of Charlottesville; Colonel Perry, Secretary of Charlottesville Chamber of Commerce; Mr. Loth of Waynesboro Chamber of Commerce; Fred Cobb of Massamutten Caverne; and others spoke in support of the requested road.

The Chairman stated that the matter had been under study by the Department since June and that the study would be accelerated and a decision given when possible.

It was stated by the Chairman that the next scheduled meeting of the Councillon would probably be held in Richmond on Thursday, October 4.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 10:55 A.M.
