## Minutes of the Meeting of the State Highway Commission of Virginia, Held in Orange, September 29,1952.

On the norming of September 29th, the State Highway Commission, consisting of Messre. Wade H. Massie, Secretary, H. G. Gilmer and Wn. H. Hest, met in the Court House at Orange, Virginia, and held a public hearing on the classification of roads in the Secondary System for the Culpsper District.

Representatives from all of the counties in the District, that were present, were heard; after which the Countesion transcoted the following business.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. East, that the bids on Route 10, Project F561 I and F605 J, 0.08 Mi. R. W.L Marion-1.5 Mi. W. WCL Marion, and 6.0 Mi. E. Washington County Line, as the allocation in Enyth County is to be spent on Route 115. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that the bids on Route 11, Project P738 AB5,4, 1.7 Mi. B. ECL Lebenon-0.22 Mi. B. ECL Lebenon, and Bridges over Big Coder Greek and Mile Greek, be rejected, and the allocation transferred to Route 26, Wytheville-South, as the rights of way on this section have not been secured. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. East, that the Commission award contract for the construction of Project F661 OB2, Route 110, 0.79 Mi. M. Russell County Line-Hansonville, to the low bidder, Jim Frank, Clinchport, Va., at his bid of \$14,641.16, and that 10% additional be set uside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work; \$869.00 for goard rail; \$284.76 for gravel rights; \$2,146.65 for surface treatment and \$946.00 for work outside slope stakes, making a total of approximately \$21,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmar, seconded by Mr. East, that the Commission award contract for the construction of Project F2060, Route 11, 2,39 Mi. H. Claypool Hill-1.55 Ki. H. Claypool Hill, to the low bidder, Jim Frank, Climbport, Ya., at his bid of \$21,868.52, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work; \$1,574.50 for surface treatment; \$506.00 for outside slope stakes and \$728.00 for guard rail, making a total of approximately \$27,000.60 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Mast, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the Commission sward contract for the construction of Project F7461, Route 15,0.23 Mi. E. Powhatan County Line, to the low bidder, Peacock and Martin, Summerfield, M.C., at their bid of \$51,606.66, and that 10% additional be set aside to over the cost of engineering and additional work; \$1,807.00 for guard rail; \$1,005.74 for soil rights; \$9,240.90 for surface treatment and \$2,075.75 for cutaids albee stakes, making a total of approximately \$49,000, chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. East, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the Commission award contract for the construction of Project F88 CEB, Houte 51, Stafford Court House-1.8 Mi. M. Granes Corner; and Bridge over Access Creek; to the low bidder, Guilford Construction Company, Inc., Greensbore, E.C., at their bid of \$144,228.12, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of sugmeering and additional work; \$1.089.00 for work outside slope stakes, and \$4,000.00 for subgrade treatment, making a total of approximately \$164,000.00 bhargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the Commission award contract for the comstruction of Project 6601 DB4, Route 48, 0.49 Mi. W. BCL Stony Greek-Dismiddia County Line; and Bridge over Sappony Creek, to the low bidder, Buffin Construction Co., Richmond, Va., at their bid of \$57,416.08, and that 10% additional be set aside to over the cost of engineering and additional work; \$591.60 for guard rail; \$684.74 for soil rights; \$8,179.05 for surface treatment and \$1,573.25 for work outside slope stakes, making a total of approximately \$52,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Hoved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that the Commission award contract for the construction of Project 7562C, Route 10, 1.28 Mi. E. BUL Selem-ECL Salem, to the low bidder, C. L. Tinaley, Rosnoke, Va., at his bid of \$20,556.16, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work; \$810.50 for guard rail; \$5,564.79 for surface treatment and \$195.25 for work outside slope stakes, making a total of approximately \$27,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

. Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Bilgis, that the Commission award contract for the construction of Project F7460, Houte 15, 5.57 Ml. W. Powhatan County Line-Powhatan Co. H., to the low hidder, R. P. Hester, Greensbore, M.Co., at his hid of \$25,717.47, and that 10% additional be set uside to cover the cost of engineering and additional works \$1,292.50 for guard rail; \$928.69 for soil rights; \$8,550.50 for surface treatment and \$1,919.25 for work outside slope stakes, making a total of approximately \$89,000.60 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned, subject to the call of the Commissioner.
