

Minutes of the Meeting of the State Highway
Commission of Virginia, Held in
Richmond, September 29, 1936.

On the morning of September 29, 1936, the State Highway Commission, consisting of Messrs. H.G. Shirley, Wade H. Massie, Secretary, Wm. H. East, S. W. Rawls and J. F. Wyszor, met in their office, State Office Building, Richmond, Virginia.

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman.

Moved by Mr. Rawls, seconded by Mr. East, that the minutes of the meeting of August 12th be approved. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Rawls, that the City of Charlottesville be granted the \$500.00 per mile additional construction funds for 1936-37 to be used in completing WPMH Project 1113D, Route 250, to provide surfacing. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Rawls, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that the City of Newport News be permitted to spend the \$500.00 per mile construction fund approved for 1936-37, on Thirty-fourth Street between Orcutt Avenue and East City Limits rather than on the Thirty-fourth Street Bridge. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Wyszor, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that the request of Salem for \$500.00 per mile additional construction funds for 1936-37 be approved for the widening of Main Street. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Rawls, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that the City of Richmond be granted the \$500.00 per mile additional construction fund for 1936-37 to apply on Route 161 between the RPAF Bridge and the Hermitage Road. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Wyszor, seconded by Mr. Rawls, that permit #20448, Arlington County, Route 211, issued March 31st to Rosslyn Gas Company, be cancelled as requested. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Rawls, that permit #14064, Rockingham County, Route 11, issued September 19, 1932, to J. E. Maury, Broadway, Va., be cancelled inasmuch as it is not known when the work will be done. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. East, seconded by Mr. Wyszor, that permit #21486, Powhatan County, Route 60, issued June 16th to the Virginia Electric and Power Company, Richmond, Va., be cancelled as requested. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. East, that whereas in the judgment of the State Highway Commission, for the handling of traffic through the Town of Buchanan, it is necessary to relocate and construct a part of State Highway Route No. 11 within the corporate limits of said town, and whereas plans have been prepared and approved by the Chief Engineer showing the relocation of Route No. 11, which plans are known as State Highway Project 721 M2B2, and approved June 9, 1956, and revised July 20 and September 10, 1956; and whereas the Chief Executive and the Town Council, the governing body of the Town of Buchanan, have consented to the proposed relocation and construction of Route No. 11 within the corporate limits of said town, in accordance with the aforesaid plans; now, therefore, be it resolved that this Commission doth hereby ratify and confirm the action of the Chief Engineer in preparing and approving the said plans, and doth hereby adopt the same, and be it further resolved that the roads, streets, bridge, and rights of way as shown in the above mentioned plans are hereby incorporated in the State highway system. Moved by Mr. Bawls, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that whereas the 60 ft. right of way which has been secured on Route 11, Project 800J, in Augusta County, as shown on sheets 13 and 15 of plans of the above project, is sufficient for road purposes, and whereas it appears that no part of the old road lying outside of said right of way between Stations 5136/71 and 5152/65 will be embraced in the State highway system, said portion of the old road lying outside of said right of way between the above stations is hereby abandoned as a part of the State highway. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Wyser, seconded by Mr. Bawls, that whereas on the 25th day of June, 1936, H. G. Shirley, Chairman of the State Highway Commission, filed an application before this Commission requesting that certain portions of old Route 19 be abandoned altogether as a public road, in accordance with the provisions of section 2, chapter 212, of the Acts of 1928; and whereas it was ordered by the Commission on the 25th day of June, 1936, that notice pursuant to the above statute be posted at the Court House of Taxswell County, Virginia, and that a copy of said notice be sent to the Board of Supervisors of Taxswell County by registered mail; and same was complied with, and whereas no petition was filed by any landowner in said county requesting that a public hearing be held by said Commission for the purpose of determining whether or not the said portion of the said road be abandoned; and whereas this Commission is satisfied that no public necessity exists for a continuance of the said section of road described in the aforesaid notice and application; it is hereby ordered that the following sections of old Route No. 19 be abandoned altogether as a public road upon completion of the new road.-

Said sections are shown on plans on file at office of Department of Highways, Richmond, Virginia. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Wyser, that whereas the town authorities of St. Paul have requested the State Highway Commission to relocate a portion of Route 70 through the Town so as to avoid a grade crossing, the Commission hereby adopts Wise Street from Fifth Avenue to Fourth Avenue, thence in a southerly direction along Fourth Avenue and Fourth Avenue proposed to intersect present State Route 64, as the State highway, with the understanding that the present crossing on Route 70 is closed when the undergrade crossing on the proposed new location has been constructed and opened to traffic. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Wyser, seconded by Mr. Rawls, that whereas the 40 ft. right of way which has been secured on Secondary Route 658 in Buchanan County, between the points shown on map made by the Norfolk and Western Railway and known as Y-10325-A, is sufficient for road purposes, and whereas it appears that no part of the old road, lying outside of said right of way, between points shown on said plan as Station Q/00 and Station 41/40, will be required for road purposes, the portion of the old road between said Stations is hereby abandoned upon completion of the new road. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Rawls, seconded by Mr. Wyser, that the position of Safety Engineer be created, and the salary be \$3,000.00 per year. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Wyser, seconded by Mr. Rawls, that Mr. Wade H. Massie be reappointed as secretary of the Commission, in compliance with the law. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Rawls, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the annual report of the Commission be approved and forwarded to the Governor, for 1935-36. Motion carried.

Mr. I. D. Scott of Lynchburg, appeared before the Commission concerning insurance placed by the Department, rescinding of present contracts and the picking up of contracts at their expiration.

Moved by Mr. Rawls, seconded by Mr. Massie, that no change be made in the insurance contracts as awarded, for insurance on State Highway property, and no insurance be placed until all policies have expired. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Rawls, that the policy of allowing five days extension of time on winter work on projects be discontinued and the Chief Engineer be instructed to make recommendations as to the exact time that should be allowed contractors due to difficulties beyond their control. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. East, seconded by Mr. Massie, that request from the Lexington Business and Professional Women's Club for the improvement of Route 601 through Goshen Pass, be taken up at the annual meeting allocating funds. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Rawls, seconded by Mr. East, that the request of Mr. C. W. Harman for change in agreement concerning fence on his property along Route 11, Project 1008 A2, in Pulaski County, be refused but that the Commission pay Mr. Harman an amount for the right of way through his other property on the same Route sufficient to rebuild his fence. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Rawls, that request of the Board of Supervisors of Bedford County to add to the Federal Aid System the road from Bedford to Rocky Mount, be not granted. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Rawls, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that request to erect a sign at the intersection of Routes 58 and 460 at Magnolia, directing west-bound truck traffic over Route 58 and south-bound traffic over Route 460, from Magnolia to Suffolk, be granted. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. East, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that \$2,000.00 be set aside to make surveys from Staunton west towards Chrookville on Route 260. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. East, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that any balances be used to widen the Naked Creek Bridge on Route 12 at Verbana. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Wycor, that whereas the State Highway Commission has given public notice, as required under Chapter 212, Acts of 1928 for the changing of the overhead bridge at Ivy Station on Route 260, to a pedestrian bridge, and whereas objections to this change have been filed in writing and a hearing requested, it is ordered that a public hearing be held at the Courthouse in Charlottesville on Thursday, November 12th at 2:30 o'clock to consider this question. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Rawls, that the sick leave of W. R. Smith be extended one month with pay, from September 1st through the 30th. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Rawls, that the sick leave of B. R. Parker be extended 30 days with pay, being the month of August. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Rawls, seconded by Mr. East, that the sick leave of Colonel F. R. Marshall be extended for one month with pay, being from August 22nd to September 22nd. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Rawls, that the sick leave of Miss Mildred Michie be extended for one month with pay, being the month of August. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Rawls, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that the request of the Roanoke Iron and Bridge Works, Inc., Roanoke, Va., for permit to haul steel of a greater length than specified in Chapter 342, Acts of 1952, be not granted. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Rawls, that the request of the Virginia Public Service Co., Harrisonburg, Va., for permit to erect a guy pole on the right of way of Route 11, 0.5 mile south of Mt. Sidney, be not granted. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Rawls, that request of the Virginia Electric and Power Company, Fredericksburg, Va., for permits to erect one pole and make one crossing on Route 1, in Spotsylvania County, to the Japanese Beetle Quarantine Station, be turned down with the understanding that the stations be removed from the highways in the near future. Motion carried.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned subject to the call of the Commissioner.
