

Minutes of the Meeting of the State Highway  
Commission of Virginia, Held in  
Richmond, September 25, 1937.

On the morning of September 25, the State Highway Commission, consisting of Messrs. H. G. Shirley, Wade H. Massie, Secretary, Wm. H. East, S. W. Rawls, and J. F. Wysor, met in their office, State Office Building, Richmond, Virginia.

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman.

Moved by Mr. Rawls, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the minutes of the meeting of August 25th be approved. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Rawls, seconded by Mr. Wysor, that the Commission confirm award of contract for the construction of Project NHE 565 182JS, MS, Route 250, 4.1 Mi. W. Ferncliffe-5.89 Mi. E. Shadwell, to the low bidder, Sam E. Finley, Roanoke, Va., at his bid of \$73,040.81, reducing the overhead from 10% to 5%, making a total of approximately \$76,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. East, seconded by Mr. Wysor, that the Commission confirm award of contract for the construction of Project PA 292 A2,3, Route 29, 1.1 Mi. S. SUL Gresham-MCL Gresham, to the low bidder, Baynes Construction Company, Chatham, Va., at their bid of \$81,276.07, that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, and \$220.00 for moving pole lines, making a total of approximately \$90,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Wysor, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the Commission confirm award of contract for the construction of Project NHE 1036 11,2, Route 60, R.E.Lee Bridge-C&O Overpass, Second Street Approach Road-City of Richmond, to the low bidder, H.K. Williams, Richmond, Va., at his bid of \$3,850.00, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$3,700.00 chargeable to this project, provided the City of Richmond will put up the \$350.00 difference needed. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Wysor, that the Commission confirm award of contract for the construction of Project NHE 1000 C&I, Route 207, Fort Conway-Intersection Route 5 at Office Hall, to the low bidder, Short and Thompson, Inc., Hopewell, Va., at their bid of \$16,241.41, that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work and \$56.00 for moving poles, making a total of approximately \$21,000.00 chargeable to this project, transferring \$7,331.39 from Project NHE 565 182JS, MS, Route 250, to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Rawls, seconded by Mr. East, that the Commission confirm award of contract for the construction of Project FA 142 FRSI, 869 AB, 688 ASI, Routes 460 and 501, SCL Lynchburg-1.5 Mi. S. of Route 460, to the low bidder, Sam E. Finley, Roanoke, Va., at his bid of \$31,727.96, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$36,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Wysor, that the Commission confirm award of contract for the construction of Project WPGS 1554 DEI, Routes 617 and 618, Spur of Southern R.R. and S.A.L. RR Overpasses and Approaches, near Franklin, to the low bidder, W. W. Scott, Franklin, Va., at his bid of \$28,368.06, that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, \$68.00 for moving poles and \$1,480.00 for work by the Railroad, making a total of approximately \$33,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. East, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that the Commission confirm award of contract for the construction of Project NRS 10C9 1B, 4B, C1B, C2B, H1B, H2B, PB, Route 30, 15.2 Miles-Midway Garage, Intersection Route 360-Intersection Route 2, to the low bidder, Sam E. Finley, Roanoke, Va., at his bid of \$21,952.96, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work; confining the work to amount of allocation of \$23,902.32. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Rawls, that the Commission confirm award of contract for the construction of Project FA 733 E, Route 19, 0.52 Mi. E. ECL Lebanon-ECL Lebanon, to the low bidder, Rosenbaum Bros. Inc., Pocahontas, Va., at their bid of \$9,368.70, that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work and \$110.00 for moving pole lines, making a total of approximately \$11,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Wysor, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the Commission confirm award of contract for the construction of Project FASG 338 0, Route 42, 0.81 Mi. S. WCL Harrisonburg-1.64 Miles S. WCL Harrisonburg, to the low bidder, Nelson H. Clark and Sons, Luray, Va., at their bid of \$27,218.71, that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work and \$418.00 for moving poles, making a total of approximately \$31,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Wysor, seconded by Mr. Rawls, that the Commission award contract for the construction of Project NRS 667 ARI, Route 14, Relocation at Cow Creek Mills, to the low bidder, Battershill Jones and Company, Big Stone Gap, Va., at their bid of \$18,384.90, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$21,000.00 chargeable to this project; using approximately \$5,000.00 State funds from the supplementary allocation fund. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. East, that Commission award contract for the construction of Project FA 1118 A1B, A2B, Route 299, 1.48 Mi. E. Route 68 at Bowers Hill-Intersection Route 27, to the low bidder, Roberts Paving Company, Washington, D.C., at their bid of \$144,887.72, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$160,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. East, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the Commission award contract for the construction of Project FA 284 A1L, B1L, Route 17, Elm Avenue in Portsmouth-0.53 Mi. S. SCL Portsmouth, to the low bidder, F.J. McGuire, Box 28, Norfolk, Va., at his bid of \$26,359.19, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$28,000.00 chargeable to this project; the necessary \$13,000.00 required to be supplied from unprogrammed balances. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Rawls, seconded by Mr. Wysor, that the Commission award contract for the construction of Project HWM 1054 H4, Route 10, City of Hopewell, Appomattox River Bridge-0.13 Mi. E. Appomattox River Bridge on Randolph Street, to the low bidder, B. W. Jackson, Inc., Richmond, Virginia, at his bid of \$10,521.25, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$12,000 chargeable to this project; work to be cut off to come within the allocation unless the City of Hopewell puts up the difference. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Rawls, that the Commission award contract for the construction of Project FA 1003 F, Route 260, 5.11 Mi. E. West Virginia Line-5 Mi. W. Monterey, to the low bidder, Perkins-Barnes Construction Company, Blackstone, Va., at their bid of \$70,530.24, that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, and \$220.00 for moving pole lines, making a total of approximately \$78,000.00 chargeable to this project; the work to be extended 10% of the amount of contract if approval can be secured from the Bureau. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. East, seconded by Mr. Rawls, that the Commission award contract for the construction of Project FA 799 A1L, CS, D1L, Route 68, 13.1 Mi. W. SCL Independence-9.1 Mi. W. Mouth of Wilson, to the low bidder, Pendleton Construction Corp., Wytheville, Va., at their bid of \$72,458.30, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$80,000.00 chargeable to this project; the work to be extended 10% of the amount of contract if approval can be secured from the Bureau. Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that permit No. 80 on Route 58, Lee County, be issued to the Ewing Water Company, Ewing, Va., to maintain water mains already in place in the Town of Ewing, between M.P. 58 and M.P. 59. That permit issued in the first instance to A. B. Richmond to lay these water mains be cancelled. Motion carried.
