Minutes of the Meeting of the State Highway Commission of Virginia, Held in Highwayd, September 26, 1949.

At 10:30 A.M. the following members of the Commission assembled in the auditorium to witness the opening of bids under the Revenue Bond Act, Chapter 399, Act approved April 1, 1949. Upon completion of the opening of the bids the Commission met in executive assession in the Commission Rome. Present - Massrs. B. P. Barrow, J. P. Harpine, S. W. Rawls, Howard C. Rogers, Tucker C. Wetkins, Jr., and J. A. Anderson.

The Chairman told the Commission that on advice of Mr. James Mallen, the local legal advicer, and the New York representatives who were employed as Bond Commel, it was necessary to call the Commission in session today to formally sear the contract on bids received under the Revenue Sond Act at 10:30 A.M. this day. The Chairman expressed his regret for having to send out a call on Friday, September 23, for the meeting.

Moved by Mr. Rawls, seconded by Mr. Barrow, that the request of E. W. Grannis Company and Lewis and Rowsan, Contractors, for an extension of time on Project F-1284-44.Bl, Routes 15, 186-Y, 170 and 460, the Triple Decker at Norfolk, be granted for sixty (80) days and the return of \$800.00. Motion carried.

Hoved by Mr. Barrow, seconded by Mr. Harpine, that the Compission confirm award of contract on bids rescived September 15, for the construction of Project 2802-01, Route 20, 0.227 Mr. S. of SCL Charlottesville-6.559 Mr. S. of SCL Charlottesville, to the low bidder, A. B. Torrence Co., Elkton, Va., on the regular bid, at the not bid of \$145,700.74, that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work and \$560.17 for work by State Forces, making a total of approximately \$160,800.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Harpino, seconded by Mr. Rogers, that the Commission confirm award of contract on bids received September 15, for the construction of Project 1347-O1, Route 603, 0.687 Mi. S. of S. Intersection of Route 601-1.218 Mi. H. of Intersection of Route 610, James City County, to the low bidder, C. H. Lawson, Williamsburg, Va., at the bid of \$17,997.64 and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$19,800.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Rogors, seconded by Mr. Rawls, that the Commission confirm award of contract on bids received September 16, for the construction of Project 1973-01-02, Route 16, 4.579 Mi. N. of MCL Keysville-2.775 Mi. N. of MCL Keysville, to the low bidder, Borfolk Contracting Company, Horfolk, Va., at the bid of \$93,269.93, that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, \$4,352.00 for work by the MaN RR and \$538.00 for work by the Virginian Railway, making a total of approximately \$107,450.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Rawls, seconded by Mr. Watkins, that the Commission confirm award of contract on bids received September 15, for the construction of Project 2127-Ol, Route 60, 0.269 Mi. W. of WCL Hampton-0.847 Mi. R. of ECL Newport News, to the low bidder, Birsch Construction Co., Norfolk, Va., at the bid of \$25,949.75 and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$28,350.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Notice carried.

W. of Int. Route 608-Int. Route 48 (N. of Danieltown): Int. Route 48 (S. of Danieltown)-0.024 Mi. N. of Int. Route 618, to the low bidder, Marrow Bros., Construction Company, Townsville, M. C., at the bid of \$52,422.52 and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$67,680.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Rogers, seconded by Mr. Harpine, that the Commission confirm award of contract on bids received September 16, for the construction of Project 1389-C1, Route 63C, 5.043 Mi. West of Route 1-Intersection Route 648, to the low bidder, R. H. Rose, Richmond, Ya., at the bid of \$17,381.16 and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$19,100.00 chargeable to this project. Motion parried.

Moved by Mr. Harpine, seconded by Mr. Barrow, that the Commission confirm award of contract on bids received September 15, for the construction of project 1320-01-02, Route 686, WCL Richmond-Intersection Route 678 (Mear Bon Air) to the low bidder, W. H. Scott, Franklin, Va., at the bid of \$61,972.85 and that 10% additional be set awide to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$68,150.00 chargeable to this project. Notion carried.

Moved by Mr. Barrow, seconded by Mr. Watkins, that the Commission confirm award of contract on bids received September 15, for the construction of Project 1860-01-02-04-05, Route 11, 2,227 Mi. E. of Elliston-1.469 Mi. W. of Elliston, to the low bidder, Albert Bros., Contractors, Inc., Salem, Va., on regular bid, at the bid of \$589,388.76, that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work and \$9,667.00 for work by State Forces, making a total of approximately \$657,950.00 chargesble to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Watkins, seconded by Mr. Rogers, that the Commission confirm award of contract on bids received September 15, for the construction of Project 6692-01-02-05. Route 16, 0.206 Mi. S. of NOL Tasewell-0.271 Mi. N. of SCL North Tasewell, to the low bidder, Noese Construction Company, Mytheville, Va., at the bid of \$29,261.30, that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work and \$1,119.80 for work by State Forces, making a total of approximately \$33,300.00 chargeable to this project; additional \$5,800.00 required to be secured from the Bristol District Reserve. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Harpine, seconded by Mr. Rogers, that the Commission confirm rejection of bids received September 15, for One Scale Truck Weighing Station - South Sids of Route 301 between Potomas River Bridge and Intersection of Route 206, King George County, Route 301, Project 1848-01, the low bid being 64.8% over estimate, and readvertise the project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Berrow, seconded by Mr. Rogers, that the Commission confirm rejection of bids received September 15, for Two Scale Truck Weighing Station on U. S. Highway No. 15-1.84 Mi. S. of Virginia-Maryland State Line, Accommok County, Route 13, Project 1801-05, the low bid being 43.7% over estimate and readvertise the project. Notion carried.

Moved by Mr. Rawls, seconded by Mr. Barrow, that the Commission confirm rejection of bids received September 15, for Two Scale Truck Weighing Station on U. S. Highway No. 1 South of Woodbridge, Prince William County, Route 1, Project 1676-02, the low bid being 13.5% over estimate, and the project be readvertised. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Rogers, seconded by Mr. Barrow, that the Commission confirm award of contract on bids received September 15, for the construction of Projects 1503-01; 1308-01, Route 606, Bath and Alleghany Counties, 4.412 Mi. W. of WCL Clifton Forge-Intersection Route 220, to the low bidder, C. A. Farrent, Lexington, Va., at the bid of \$68,718.50, provided it is satisfactory to the contractor and the U. S. Forest Service to climinate the item of 41,776 sq. yds. of Stabilized Base Course and bring the amount within the estimate, in event this is not agreeable the bid is to be rejected and the project readvertised as the low bid is 14.4% over estimate. Motion carried,

Moved by Mr. Barrow, seconded by Mr. Watkins, that no bids having been received on September 15 nn Project 2796-01-02-03, Routes 205 and 2057, WCL Colonial Beach-0.134 Mi. E. of WCL Colonial Beach (Colonial Avenue), Westmoreland County, the project be restudied for final determination. Motion parried.

Moved by Mr. Barrow, seconded by Mr. Watkins, that the closing of the following sections of old Route 15 in Madison County, having been advertised and no objections filed thereto, the same are hereby designed abandoned and climinated from the Primary Highway System, all as provided by Chapter 212, Section 2, Act approved March 19, 1956:

- Section 1 Old location of Route 15 from new location at Station 616,000 looping southerly 1.05 mi. to Sta. 675,25.

 Length 1.03 Mi.
- Section 2 Old location of Route 15 from the new location at Sta. 687,00 looping southerly 2.02 Mi. to Sta. 793,55.

- Section 3 From the new location at Sta. 794/10 southwest 0.18 Mi. to the right of way line on Rt. 230 Length 0.18 Mi.

Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Barrow, assembled by Mr. Harpine, that the closing of the following sections of old Route 6 in Goodhland County having been advertised and no objections filed thereto, the same are hereby declared abandoned and climinated from the Primary Highway System, all as provided by Chapter 212, Section 2, Act approved March 19, 1926:

Section 1 - Old location of Route 6 from the present right of way line opposite Sta. 721/20 northwest 0.30 Mi. to the present right of way line at a point opposite Sta. 736/30.

Length 0.30 Mi.

Section 2 - Old location of Route 6 from the present right of way line at a point opposite Sta. 747/00 northwest 0.42 ML to the present right of way line opposite Sta. 766/26. Length 0.42 ML.

Notion carried.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned at 11:46 A.M. and proceeded to Rusger's for lunch.
