### MEETING OF THE COMMONWEALTH TRANSPORTATION BOARD

Martha Washington Inn, Abingdon, Virginia September 21, 1989

The monthly meeting of the Commonwealth Transportation Board was held at the Martha Washington Inn, Abingdon, Virginia, on September 21, 1989. The chairman, Mr. Ray D. Pethtel, presided.

Present: Messrs. Pethtel, Bacon, Beyer, Davidson, Howlette, Humphreys, Kelly, Leafe, Malbon, Musselwhite, Quicke, Smalley and Waldman and Mrs. Kincheloe and Dr. Thomas.

On motion of Mr. Bacon, seconded by Mr. Musselwhite, permits issued and canceled from August 17, 1989 to September 20, 1989, inclusive, as shown by the records of the Department, were approved.

Moved by Mr. Bacon, seconded by Mr. Musselwhite, that

WHEREAS, by proper resolutions, the Boards of: Supervisors of Amelia, Mecklenburg and Hurry Counties have requested that certain roads which no longer serve as a public necessity be discontinued as parts of the Secondary System of Highways;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that pursuant to Section 33.1-150 of the Code of Virginia of 1950, as amended, the following roads are discontinued as parts of the Secondary System of Highways, effective this date.

Amelia County - Route 615 - From Route 708 to 0.07 mile West Route 708.

Mecklenburg County - Route 620 - From Station 10+ 12.17 to Station 13 + 30.00. 0.08 I.

Surry County - Route 626 - From Station 51+47 to Station 58+50. 0.14 Mi.

Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Bacon, seconded by Mr. Musselwhite, that the Board approve additions and abandonments to the Secondary System from August 1, 1989 to August 31, 1989, inclusive, as shown by the records of the Department. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Bacon, seconded by Mr. Musselwhite, that

WHEREAS, the Commonwealth Transportation Board is authorized under Section 33.1-41.1 of the Code of Virginia, as amended, to approve payments to cities and certain towns for street maintenance purposes; and

WHEREAS, certain principal-minor arterial roads and/or collector-local streets within the corporate limits of the City of South Boston are eligible for such payment; and

WHEREAS, under the authority of Section 33.1-41.1, request is made by the City of South Boston, for maintenance payments on streets meeting the required criteria;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that quarterly payments to the City of South Boston for streets be increased by 0.90 centerline mile. This increase is a result of additions of local streets as described on tabulation sheet number 1 for the City of South Boston dated August 11, 1989. The tabulation sheets are on file in the Department's Urban Division.

The street additions totaling 0.90 centerline mile increases the total mileage to 34.34 centerline miles of approved streets subject to maintenance payments.

Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Bacon, seconded by Mr. Musselwhite, that

WHEREAS, the Commonwealth Transportation Board is authorized under Section 33.1-41.1 of the Code of Virginia, as amended, to approve payments to cities and certain towns for street maintenance purposes; and

WHEREAS, certain principal-minor arterial roads and/or collector-local streets within the corporate limits of the City of Chesapeake are eligible for such payment; and

WHEREAS, under the authority of Section 33.1-41.1, request is made by the City of Chesapeake, for the deletion of maintenance payments on streets meeting the required criteria;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that quarterly payments to the City of Chesapeake for streets be decreased by 0.30 centerline mile. This decrease is a result of deletions of local streets as described on tabulation sheet number 1 for the City of Chesapeake dated July 19, 1989. The tabulation sheets are on file in the Department's Urban Division.

The street deletion totaling 0.30 centerline mile decreases the total mileage to 534.24 centerline miles of approved streets subject to maintenance payments.

Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Bacon, seconded by Mr. Musselwhite, that

WHEREAS, the Commonwealth Transportation Board is authorized under Section 33.1-41.1 of the Code of Virginia, as amended, to approve payments to cities and certain towns for street maintenance purposes; and

WHEREAS, certain principal-minor arterial roads and/or collector-local streets within the corporate limits of the City of Petersburg are eligible for such payment; and

WHEREAS, under the authority of Section 33.1-41.1, request is made by the City of Petersburg, for maintenance payments on street/roads meeting the required criteria;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that quarterly payments to the City of Petersburg for streets/roads be increased by 0.78 centerline mile. This increase is a result of additions of local streets as described on tabulation sheet number 1 for the City of Petersburg dated June 15, 1989. The tabulation sheets are on file in the Department's Urban Division.

The street addition totaling 0.78 centerline mile increases the total mileage to 119.06 centerline miles of approved streets subject to maintenance payments.

Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Bacon, seconded by Mr. Musselwhite, that

WHEREAS, the Commonwealth Transportation Board is authorized under Section 33.1-41.1 of the Code of Virginia, as amended, to approve payments to cities and certain towns for street maintenance purposes; and

WHEREAS, certain principal-minor arterial roads and/or collector-local streets within the corporate limits of the City of Petersburg are eligible for such payment; and

WHEREAS, under the authority of Section 33.1-41.1 request is made by the City of Petersburg, for maintenance payments on streets/roads meeting the required criteria;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that quarterly payments to the City of Petersburg for streets/roads having a net increase of 2.36 centerline miles. This increase is a result of additions and deletions of minor arterial roads and local streets as described on tabulation sheets numbered 1 through 2 for the City of Petersburg dated August 29, 1989. The tabulation sheets are on file in the Department's Urban Division.

The street/road net additions totaling 2.36 centerline miles increases the total mileage to 180.64 centerline miles of approved streets subject to maintenance payments.

Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Bacon, seconded Mr. Musselwhite, that

WHEREAS, Section 33.1-41.1 of the Code of Virginia, as amended, provides for the purpose of calculating urban maintenance allocations and approving maintenance payments, that the Department of Transportation shall divide affected roads and streets into two categories: (1) Principal and Minor Arterial Roads, and (2) Collector and Local Streets; and

WHEREAS, the Department established a State Functional classification System and a Urban Maintenance Inventory depicting those roads and streets eligible to receive subject maintenance payments; and

WHEREAS, such maintenance payments shall be based on the number of moving-lane miles of such roads and streets available to peak-hour traffic in each category in each locality; and

WHEREAS, payments for each category shall be made at a rate prescribed in Section 33.1-41.1 for fiscal year 1986 and adjusted as prescribed for subsequent years; and

WHEREAS, funds allocated by the Board for such maintenance payments shall be paid in equal sums in each quarter of the fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, no payment shall be made without the approval of the Board;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the yearly and quarterly payments for each locality are hereby approved as indicated on the attached tabulation.

21+35 (office revised centerline) to a point approximately 20 feet opposite approximate Station 22+60 (office revised centerline) do not constitute sections of the public road and are deemed by him no longer necessary for the uses of the Secondary System of State Highways.

NOW, THEREFORE, in accordance with the provisions of Section 33.1-154 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, the conveyance of the said lands, so certified, is approved and the Commonwealth Transportation Commissioner is authorized to execute in the name of the Commonwealth quitclaim deeds to the adjoining landowners of record for considerations acceptable to the State Right of Way Engineer, subject to such restrictions as may be deemed requisite.

WHEREAS, in connection with Route 288, State Highway Project 0288-020-101-RW201, the Commonwealth acquired certain lands from Edward L. Kersey and Ruth O. Kersey by instrument dated December 12, 1973, recorded in Deed Book 1122, Page 302, case for which has been concluded, and from Sarah Turner Sinclair by instrument dated November 13, 1972, recorded in Deed Book 1064, Page 267, case for which has been concluded. These instruments are recorded in the Office of the Clerk of the Circuit Court of Chesterfield County; and

WHEREAS, the land was acquired for a service Road to provide access; and

WHEREAS, said Service Road is no longer required; and

WHEREAS, the adjacent landowners have requested that the Commonwealth convey the lands, so acquired, for the Service Road so that the adjacent lands may be fully developed; and

WHEREAS, the Commonwealth Transportation Commissioner has certified in writing that the lands comprising the Service Road lying south of and adjacent to the south right of way line of Route 10, from a point approximately 55 feet opposite approximate Station 440+80 (NBL centerline) to a point approximately 50 feet opposite approximate Station 441+35 (NBL centerline, containing 0.93 acre, more or less, does not constitute a section of the public road and is deemed by him no longer necessary for the uses of the State Highway System.

NOW, THEREFORE, the conveyance of the said land, in accordance with the provisions of Section 33.1-149 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, is approved and the Commonwealth Transportation Commissioner is hereby authorized to execute in the name of the Commonwealth deeds, without warranty, conveying same to the adjacent landowners of record for considerations satisfactory to the Department, subject to such restrictions as may be deemed requisite.

WHEREAS, in connection with Route 611, State Highway Project 0611-050-145, N-501, the Commonwealth acquired certain lands from Thomas Hardyman and Roberta Hardyman by deed dated June 4, 1987, recorded in Deed Book 171, Page 722; and by Omnibus deed from C. R. Bassett, et al, by deed dated October 14, 1964, recorded in Deed Book 90, Page 288. These deeds are recorded in the Office of the Clerk of the Circuit Court of King William County; and

WHEREAS, under Project 0611-050-145, N-501, a portion of Route 611 was relocated serving the same citizens as before; and

WHEREAS, at a meeting of the Board of Supervisors of King William County, held on November 22, 1988, a resolution was passed abandoning a portion of old Route 611, effective February 3, 1989; and

WHEREAS, in order to more fully develop the property, the owners of the adjacent land have requested that the excess right of way, so acquired, be conveyed to them; and

WHEREAS, the Commonwealth Transportation Commissioner has certified in writing that the right of way comprising approximately 3.8171 acres, more or less, land and lying south of the south proposed right of way line of Route 611, from a point approximately 30 feet opposite approximate Station 31+25 (Route 611 centerline) to a point approximately 34 feet opposite approximate Station 39+52 (Route 611 centerline) does not constitute a section of the public road and is deemed by him no longer necessary for the uses of the Secondary System of State Highways.

NOW, THEREFORE, the conveyance of the said parcel of land, so certified, in accordance with the provisions of Section 33.1-154 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, is approved and the Commonwealth Transportation Commissioner is hereby authorized to execute in the name of the Commonwealth deeds, without warranty, conveying same to the adjoining landowners of record for considerations satisfactory to the State Right of Way Engineer, subject to such restrictions as may be deemed requisite.

WHEREAS, the Commonwealth acquired certain lands for Edgehill Area Headquarters from Wayland A. Clarke, Jr., et al, by deed dated July 14, 1964, recorded in Deed Book 88, Page 721; and from John W. Bunting by deed recorded in Deed Book 189, Page 529. These deeds are recorded in the Office of the Clerk of the Circuit Court of King George County; and

WHEREAS, the Northern Neck Electric Cooperative has requested a permanent easement to cross over, upon, or beneath a portion of the lands of the aforesaid being 15 feet in width, extending in a westerly direction for

approximately 100 feet across the area headquarters for the construction and maintenance of a power line to provide additional service to the headquarters; and

WHEREAS, the Commonwealth Transportation Commissioner has certified to the Board that he deems it expedient to convey to Northern Neck Electric Cooperative the easement for the power line.

WHEREAS, in connection with Route 29, State Highway Project 6029-023-103-RW201, the Commonwealth acquired certain lands from Atler B. Stanley and Betty J. Stanley, by deed dated April 8, 1969, recorded in Deed Book 203, Page 447, in the Office of the Clerk of the Circuit Court of Culpeper County; and

WHEREAS, a portion of the right of way, so acquired, is no longer needed; and

WHEREAS, the adjoining landowner has requested that the Commonwealth convey the excess right of way in order to more fully develop the adjacent lands; and

WHEREAS, the Commonwealth Transportation Commissioner has certified in writing that the land containing 0.61 acre, more or less, and lying southeast of and adjacent to the southeast normal right of way limits of Route 29, from a point approximately 70 feet opposite approximate Station 2522+23 (NBL centerline, Route 29) to a point approximately 70 feet opposite approximate Station 2526+10 (NBL centerline, Route 29) does not constitute a section of the public road and is deemed by him no longer necessary for the uses of the State Highway System.

NOW, THEREFORE, the conveyance of the said lands in accordance with the provisions of Section 33.1-149 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, the Commonwealth Transportation Commissioner is approved and the Commonwealth Transportation Commissioner is hereby authorized to execute in the name of the Commonwealth a deed, without warranty, to the adjoining landowner for a consideration acceptable to the State Right of Way Engineer, subject to such restrictions as may be deemed requisite.

WHEREAS, in connection with Route 64, State Highway Project 0064-114-103-RW203, the Commonwealth acquired certain lands from various landowners for use as a borrow site, known as the Chisam Borrow Pit, near the intersection of I-64 and Big Bethel Road in the City of Hampton; and

WHEREAS, it has been recommended that the borrow site lying south of the south proposed right of way line be conveyed to the City of Hampton for a future public park; and

WHEREAS, the Borrow Committee has reviewed the area to be conveyed and have agreed to the disposition; and

WHEREAS, the deed will require the City of Hampton to reconvey immediately any portion of the property needed for wetland mitigation required for the proposed East-West Expressway; and

WHEREAS, the Commonwealth Transportation Commissioner has certified in writing that the 260.81088 acres, more or less, land lying south of the south existing right of way line of Route 64, from a point approximately 125 feet opposite approximate Station 364+00 (I-64 centerline) to a point approximately 125 feet opposite approximate Station 413+25 (I-64 centerline) does not constitute a section of the public road and is deemed by him no longer necessary for the uses of the State Highway System.

NOW, THEREFORE, the conveyance of the land, so certified, in accordance with the provisions of Section 33.1-149 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, is approved and the Commonwealth Transportation Commissioner is hereby authorized to execute in the name of the Commonwealth a deed conveying same for a consideration satisfactory to the State Right of Way Engineer and subject to such restrictions as may be deemed requisite.

Moved by Mr. Smalley, seconded by Mr. Kelly, that

WHEREAS, Section 33.1-221 of the Code of Virginia provides a fund to "... be expended by the Board for constructing, reconstructing, maintaining or improving access roads within counties, cities and towns to industrial sites on which manufacturing, processing or other establishments will be built under firm contract or are already constructed and to publicly owned airports; ...";

WHEREAS, the Smyth County Board of Supervisors has, by resolution, requested industrial access funds to serve the proposed facilities of Merillat Industries, Inc. to be located off Route 686 in the Atkins area of Smyth County, and said access is estimated to cost \$150,000; and

WHEREAS, it appears that this request falls within the intent of Section 33.1-221 and has complied with the provisions of the Commonwealth Transportation Board's policy on the use of industrial access funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that \$150,000 of the 1989-90 Industrial Access Fund be allocated to provide adequate access to the proposed facility of Merillat Industries, Inc. located off Route 686 south of its intersection with Route 795 in Smyth County, Project 0795-086-200, M501, contingent upon:

- all necessary right of way and utility adjustments being provided at no cost to the Industrial Access Fund; and
- documentary evidence being provided that the industry's production facilities, with a total eligible capital outlay of not less than \$1.5 million, is under firm contract for the construction and operations of its plant at this site.

Moved by Mr. Bacon, seconded by Mr. Davidson, that

WHEREAS, the Nelson County Board of Supervisors by unanimous Vote on March 14, agreed to the renumbering of sections of state Routes 6 and 151; and

WHEREAS, the Albemarle County Board of Supervisors has submitted a resolution concurring in the renumbering of these sections of state Routes 6 and 151; and

WHEREAS, the renumbering of said routes have been recommended by the Department's Engineers; and

WHEREAS, the Virginia Byway designation on existing state Route 6 will carry over to the renumbered state Route 151;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that state Route 6 in Nelson and Albemarle Counties, between U.S. Route 250 and Avon, shall be renumbered state Route 151; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that state Route 151 in Nelson County, between U.S. Route 250 and Avon via Afton, be renumbered as state Route 6; and

BE IT ALSO FURTHER RESOLVED, that the renumbering of said state Routes will not change the segment of the highway previously designated as a Virginia Byway.

Motion carried.

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that the City Council of Richmond, Virginia, and the Board of Supervisors of Henrico County, Virginia, will adopt resolutions by which they will request the Commonwealth Transportation Board to name the Parham-Chippenham connector Bridge over the James River the Edward E. Willey Memorial Bridge; and

WHEREAS, Edward E. Willey, born in Frederick County, Virginia on April 17, 1910, served the Commonwealth and its people in the Senate of Virginia from his first election to that body in 1952 until his death on July 17, 1986; and

WHEREAS, during his more than thirty-five years in the Senate, Edward E. Willey cherished, supported, and personally embodied the ideals of practical prudence, fiscal conservatism, and conscientious stewardship which have always been synonymous with the best in Virginia government; and

WHEREAS, by consistently placing the greater public good before any merely personal or parochial interests, Edward E. Willey earned the respect not only of his constituents and colleagues, but of Virginians from every part of the Commonwealth and from all walks of life; and

WHEREAS, the most valuable and durable legacy of Edward E. Willey will always remain a sound state fiscal structure upon which both a prosperous present and a productive future securely may rest; and

WHEREAS, as Chairman of the Governor's Commission on Transportation in the 21st Century, one of Edward E. Willey's last concerns was securing for the Commonwealth a transportation system adequate to sustain dynamic economic growth while also preserving the quality of life of individual citizens; and

WHEREAS, while the many achievements of Edward E. Willey have benefited all Virginians generally, they are most especially appreciated by residents of the Richmond metropolitan area;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Commonwealth Transportation Board, in accordance with the authority granted under Section 33.1-250 of the Code of Virginia, and in anticipation of appropriate resolutions from the City of Richmond and Henrico County and upon receipt of those resolutions, does hereby name the Parham-Chippenham connector Bridge (Future Route 150) over the James River, linking the City of Richmond and Henrico County the Edward E. Willey Memorial Bridge: and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that appropriate markers, as directed by the Department's Engineers, be placed calling attention to this designation.

Mr. Quicke, Chairman of the Internal Audit Committee, presented a report on the Committee's meeting of August 16, 1989. On motion of Mr. Quicke, seconded by Mr. Musselwhite, the Board adopted the report, as follows:

"The Commonwealth Transportation Board's Internal Audit Committee met on August 16, 1989, with members of the Internal Audit Division. The committee reviewed reports on the Construction Division, Culpeper District Data Center, Preliminary Engineering, Construction Payments, EEO Division, Dulles Toll Road Collection System, and Microcomputer Usage and accepts as adequate the actions taken, or to be taken, on these reports."
