#### MEETING OF THE COMMONWEALTH TRANSPORTATION BOARD

Virginia Port Authority 600 World Trade Center Norfolk, Virginia September 15, 1994 10:00 a.m.

The monthly meeting of the Commonwealth Transportation Board was held in the Board Room of the Virginia Port Authority Building in Norfolk, Virginia on September 15, 1994, at 10:00 a.m. The Chairman, Dr. Robert E. Martínez, presided.

Present: Messrs. Gehr, Barton, Byrd, Myers, Newcomb, Porter, Rhea, Rich, Roudabush, Waldman and White and Dr. Thomas, Mrs. Brooks and Mrs. Lionberger.

Absent: Dr. Howlette.

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On motion of Mrs. Brooks, seconded by Mr. White, the Board approved the minutes of the meeting of July 21, 1994.

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On motion of Mr. Roudabush, seconded by Mr. Byrd, the Board approved Permits Issued and Canceled from August 1, 1994 through August 31, 1994, inclusive.

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On motion of Dr. Thomas, seconded by Mr. Roudabush, the Board approved Additions, Abandonments or Other Changes in the Secondary System from August 1, 1994 through August 31, 1994, inclusive.

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Moved by Mr. Newcomb, seconded by Mr. Porter,

WHEREAS, Route 3 in King George County has been altered and reconstructed as shown on plans for Project 0003-048-108,C501,PE101; and

WHEREAS, one section of the old road is no longer necessary as a public road, the new road serving the same citizens as the old;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that pursuant to Section 33.1-148 of the Code of Virginia of 1950, as amended, 0.17 mile of old Route 3, designated as Section 2 on the plat dated December 27, 1993, Project 0003-048-108,C501,PE101, be abandoned as a part of the State Highway System.

WHEREAS, under the authority of Section 33.1-41.1, request is made by the Town of Front Royal for maintenance payments on Local Streets meeting the required criteria.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the street mileage eligible for quarterly payments to the Town of Front Royal for Local Streets be increased by 0.06 centerline miles. This increase is a result of additions of Local Streets as described on tabulation sheet numbered 1 through 1 for the Town of Front Royal, as functionally classified by the Transportation Planning Division dated June 28, 1994.

The tabulation sheet is on file in the Department's Urban Division.

The Local Street additions totaling 0.06 mile increases the total mileage to 47.02 centerline miles of approved streets subject to maintenance payments effective for payment beginning July 1, 1994.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the street mileage eligible for quarterly payments to the Town of Lebanon for Local Streets be increased by 0.17 centerline miles. This increase is a result of additions of Local Streets as described on tabulation sheet numbered 1 through 1 for the Town of Lebanon, as functionally classified by the Transportation Planning Division dated August 10, 1994.

The tabulation sheet is on file in the Department's Urban Division.

The Local Street additions totaling 0.17 mile increases the total mileage to 19.72 centerline miles of approved streets subject to maintenance payments effective for payment beginning July 1, 1994.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the street mileage eligible for quarterly payments to the City of Newport News for Local Streets be increased by 0.39 centerline miles. This increase is a result of additions of Local Streets as described on tabulation sheet numbered 1 through 1 for the City of Newport News, as functionally classified by the Transportation Planning Division dated August 16, 1994.

The tabulation sheet is on file in the Department's Urban Division.

The Local Street additions totaling 0.39 mile increases the total mileage to 349.48 centerline miles of approved streets subject to maintenance payments effective for payment beginning July 1, 1994.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Code of Virginia, 1950 as amended, incorporated towns having thirty-five hundred or fewer inhabitants have two choices regarding the operation of their secondary system of streets (i.e. Section 33.1-79 and Section 33.1-82); and

WHEREAS, in 1951 the Town of Victoria elected to operate under the provisions of Section 33.1-82 of the Code of Virginia, 1950 as amended, which allowed the Town to request the Department to maintain certain streets as a part of the secondary system of state highways, provided said streets met standards prescribed in the statute; and

WHEREAS, during the last 15 yers, operating under Section 33.1-82 has not resulted in the transfer of maintenance responsibility of any road mileage from the Town of Victoria to the Department because the few roads that remain under the Town's jurisdiction do not meet the miminum standards prescribed therein; and

WHEREAS, a change in the Town's mode of operations to Section 33.1-79 would allow it to transfer 0.25 mile of road mileage each fiscal year to the Department for management under its jurisdiction as part of the secondary system of state highways for maintenance; and

WHEREAS, in the belief that operating under the provisions of Section 33.1-79 will serve its residents better than presently allowed under Section 33.1-82, the Town of Victoria has requested by resolution dated June 14, 1994, that the Commonwealth Transportation Board allow a change in the Town's mode of operation, from Section 33.1-82 to Section 33.1-79, pursuant to the provisions and limitations cited therein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Commonwealth Transportation Board hereby approves the Town of Victoria's request to change its mode of operation and to make additions to the secondary system of state highways for maintenance pursuant to Section 33.1-79 of the Code of Virginia, subject to the limitations cited therein.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the roads in the Town of Victoria, hereafter added to the secondary system of state highways for maintenance shall be maintained, improved, constructed and reconstructed in accordance with the policies and regulations so governing.

Motion carried.

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Moved by Mr. Myers, seconded by Dr. Thomas, that

WHEREAS, Section 33.1-221 of the Code of Virginia provides a fund to "...be expended by the Board for constructing, reconstructing, maintaining or improving access roads within counties, cities and towns to industrial sites on which manufacturing, processing or other establishments will be built under firm contract or are already constructed and to publicly owned airports;" and

WHEREAS, the Petersburg City Council has, by appropriate resolution, requested Industrial Access Funds to serve the facilities of Diversity Foods Processing, located in the City of Petersburg, and said access is estimated to cost \$229,000; and

WHEREAS, the estimated eligible capital outlay is expected to be \$16,000,000; and

WHEREAS, it appears that this request falls within the intent of Section 33.1-221 and complies with the provisions of the Commonwealth Transportation Board's policy on the use of industrial access funds; and

WHEREAS, the City of Petersburg desires that the above access road be extended with urban funds to better serve the Petersburg Interstate Industrial Park; and

WHEREAS, said extension is expected to cost \$108,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that \$229,000 of the 1994-95 Fiscal Year Industrial Access Fund, be allocated to provide adequate access to Diversity Food Processing located in the City of Petersburg, Project 9999-123-239, C501 contingent upon:

- all necessary right of way, environmental assessments and mitigation, and utility adjustments being provided at no cost to the Commonwealth; and
- 2. documentary evidence being submitted that this firm has entered into a firm contract to construct and operate its facility at the proposed site and has expended or is under firm contract to expend at least \$2,290,000 in eligible capital outlay; and
- 3. the execution of an appropriate contractual agreement between the City of Petersburg and the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) to provide for:
- a. the design, administration, construction, and maintenance of this project;
- b. the payment of all ineligible industrial access project costs, and of any eligible industrial access project costs in excess of this allocation, from sources other than those administered by VDOT.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that an Urban Project, Project U000-123-112, C501, be programmed in the 1994-95 Fiscal Year to provide an extension of the industrial access road and that sufficient funds be allocated to accommodate this construction, with such being reflected in the fiscal Year 1995-96 Update of the Six-Year Improvement Program.

WHEREAS, Chapter 966, Item 616 of the Acts of the 1994 General Assembly provides state financial assistance for public transportation for Fiscal Year 1995 and this Chapter authorizes the Commonwealth Transportation Board to distribute these funds as public transportation grants in accordance with a distribution methodology defined in Chapter 58.1-2425 of the Code of Virginia; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Rail and Public Transportation (DRPT) has received a request for financial aid from George Mason University to conduct a project entitled the "Transit Cost Efficiency Education Program" designed to educate public officials on the merits of competitive contracting of transit services and to facilitate private sector involvement in public transportation; and

WHEREAS, George Mason University is eligible to receive the financial support and this request has been reviewed by DRPT and found to be reasonable and appropriate; and

WHEREAS, this Board finds that this project is appropriate for the efficient movement of people and therefore, for the common good of the Commonwealth.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the DRPT is authorized to award a grant of \$76,000 to George Mason University for a one-year demonstration of this program at a state participation ratio of 80% under the terms of the state public transportation demonstration grant program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of the DRPT is authorized to amend the grant as may be necessary.

WHEREAS, the bond documents for the Norfolk-Virginia Beach Toll Road require the Commonwealth Transportation Board (CTB) to approve a preliminary operations and maintenance budget; and

WHEREAS, the Board's Budget and Finance Committee received a presentation on the preliminary 1995 budget and unanimously recommends approval to the full Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Commonwealth Transportation Board that the preliminary 1995 Norfolk-Virginia Beach Toll Road operations and maintenance budget in the amount of \$5,544,467 is hereby approved.
