MENTING OF THE STATE HIGHWAY
COMMISSION OF VIRDINIA, HELD IN PARKVILLE,
OCTOBER 2107, AND AN INSPECTION TRIP OCTOMER 20TH AND 21ST, 1921.

The State Highway Commission with Henry. Ames Made E. Massie, Chairman, Henry P. Beek, Secretary, James A. Benr, Frenk W. Davie, and Horson Hardaway in attendance, assembled at the Richmond Retel on Thursday morning, Outober 20, 1921, and accompanied by George P. Coleman, Rightsay Commissioner, presented by automobile to inspect the various routes between Richmond and Toune, going out by what is known as the Control Route, via Claudala, Roxbury, Providence Morge, Windsor Shades, and Diametal; Returning by the eld Williamsburg Road, via Burtansville, Slatersville, Rew Rent, Talleysville, Bottoms Bridge, and Seven Pines, Later in the day the Commission went ever the River Road from Richmond to Providence Forge, via Malvarm Hill and Charles City Court House, returning to Richmond for the night. Throughout the day the Commission was accompanied by a number of citizens,

On Cataber Elet, 1921, the State Highway Countraien, with all members in attendance, and accompanied by Course P.Coleman, Highway Countraioner, presented by automobile from Richwood

to Petersburg over Houte No. 1, and from Petersburg
to Emporie over the proposed addition to the State
Rightery System via Carson Stony Greek and Jarratt to
Emporie. From Emporie the Commission arounded westwardly over Route No. 12 to Lawrenceville, thence over
Routes No. 1 and 12 to Lawrenceville, thence over
Routes No. 1 and 12 to Lawrence, South Hill and Boydton;
thence over Route No. 12 wis Grass City to Tyllicaburg;
thence over portions of Route No. 2 to Farmville, detouring westwardly from the present Route 2, via Dyahes
Branch, Charlotte C.N. and Abilens, this deteur being
a proposed change of Route No. 2. At Drakes Branch
the Commission was met by a number of the leading citisens and county officials, who accompanied the Commission
over the greater portion of this proposed change.

The State Righway Consission, with Vade R. Massie, Chairman, and Henry P. Beck, Secretary, June A. Bear, Frank W. Davie, and Horace Hardaway, in attendance, met in the Motel at Farmville for the transaction of Boutine business.

Open motion of Mr. Hardanny, seconded and carried, It is ordered. That permission be hereby granted

the City of Petersburg, to place a ten inch east iron water main along the most side of State Highway No. 1, north from the Bridge near Petersburg, for the purpose of supplying with water, the village of Colonial Heights and adjoining suburbe; said pipe to be placed at least ten feet from the edge of the present concrete paving.

The said City will so place the pipe as not to interfere in any way with the drainage or maintenance of the said State Sighway.

The said City will carefully back-fill after the pipe has been laid; and

If this pipe line at any time interferes with the construction or maintenance of said highway, it will be removed and relocated by the said City, without cost to the State Highway Department.

This permission shall be reverable at the will of the Commission, or its successors, and the City shall remove the said water main from the said highway at its out cost and expense, within thirty (30) days after directed to do so by this Commission, or its successors.

The City shall file its written consent to this permit within sixty (60) days from the date of this order.

Upon motion of Mr. Hardavay, seconded and entried, It is erdored, That permission be hereby granted the Olty of Norfolk to place a thirty (30) inch east from water main under State Highway No. 10, at mile post 46m43 as indicated on the attached blueprint; the top of said water main will be placed at least three (3) feet below the surface of said road.

The said City will so place the pipe as not to interfere in any way with the drainage or maintenames of the said State Highway.

The City will excefully back-fill after the pipe has been laid; and

If this pipe line at any time interferee with the comptruction or maintenance of said highway, it will be removed and relocated by the said City without cost to the State Highway Department.

This permission shall be reveable at the will of the Commission, or its successors, and the City shall remove the said water main from the said highway at its own cost and expense, within thirty(30) days after directed to do so by this Commission, or its successors.

The City shall file its written sensent to this permit within eixty (60) days from the date of this order.

On motion of Mr. Bear, the sum of #15,000 was allegated for construction purposes by convicts on Route So, 16 between Wadison Court House and Crange.

Highway Commissioner Coleman reported the allocation of \$1050, in the maintenance budget for corface treatment of the Streets of Amberst,

On motion of Nr. Bear the Commission than adjourned, subject to the call of the Chairman, and the various wembers departed for their respective homes.
