MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE STATE HICHMAY COMMISSION, RICHMOND, VA. OCTOMER Sen, 1925.

On the morning of Cotober Sth, 1925, the State Highway Commission, occasisting of Mesors. H. O. Shirley, Chairman, Wade H. Mansie, Secretary, H. B. Spreal, and A. J. Huff, met at their office, 314 State Office Smilding, Richmond, Yirginia, The meeting was called to order by the Chairman.

A delegation from the Denville Chamber of Commerce and Pittaylvania County, headed by Mr. Holland, appeared before the Commission and affered to lean \$75,000.00 for the construction of a section of Route 14 from near Gretpe morth to Hart, a distance of nine miles, this money to be loaned the Counts-sien temperarily until funds are available in the early part of 1926. This offer was made so as to give an opportunity to those who had their cross destroyed in the saighborhood of Whittle by a severe bell storm, to work as well as their teams to make a lively bood until they could have the benefit of another season's grope. The delegation was advised by the Commission that they would take the matter up and reader a decision before the meeting adjourned.

A delegation from Waverly, Suesex and Surry Counties, headed by Secator W. D. Rogers and Captain George A. Savage, came before the Constanton
