MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE STATE
HIGHWAY COMMISSION OF VIRGINIA, HELD
AT RICHMOND, VA., OCTOBER 26th, 1925.

On the morning of the 26th, the State Highway Commission, consisting of Messrs. H. C. Shirley, Chairman, Wade H. Massie, Secretary, Hugh B. Sproul, L. Malke Truxton and A. J. Huff, met at their office, State Office Building, Richmond, Virginia.

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman.

The minutes of the meeting of the Commission, held October 8th, 1925 were then read and it was moved by Mr. Sproul, seconded by Mr. Massie that they be approved. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Sproul, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that all bids be rejected on Project 187, Route 32, Bridge over Briery Creek, as they were too high, and that this work be done by force account, as per recommendation of Chief Engineer Mallon. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Huff, seconded by Mr. Massie, that all bids be rejected on Project 53910, Route 17, .16 Miles West of Goshen to .946 miles East of Millboro Springs, on account of right of way difficulties. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Sproul, seconded by Mr. Truxton, that the following permits be granted under the rules and regulations of the Commission:

To Alexandria Light & Power Company, to erect 3 poles along Route 25, Fairfax County,

To Harry S. Brown, Stafford, Virginia, to cut down bank for 135' and lay suitable drain pipe in ditch on Route 31 to provide entrance into his property,

To Chesapeake & Potomac Telephone Company to relocate 10 poles from north to south side of Route 34 in Accomac County,

To H. C. Chumbley, Christiansburg, Virginia, to lay $\frac{1}{2}$ " water line along Route 10 from City limits of Christiansburg west for a distance of 3400 feet,

- To Citizens of Colonial Heights, to construct a sidewalk, curb and gutter 2¹/₂ long State Highway 31 from top of hill north of Appomattox River to Bridge,
- To Department of Public Works, Bureau of Water, Norfolk, Virginia, to install a $\frac{3}{4}$ " lead tap under State Highway 10 for residence of Mrs. L. H. Cartwright,
- To W. H. Ellis, Strasburg, Virginia, to move a building 1220 feet along Route 33 for a distance of 300 feet in Town of Strasburg,
- To Town of Fairfax, to construct a 4" sidewalk along State Highway No. 36,
- To James H. Fletcher, Sperryville, Va. to lay pipe along Route 21, Rappahannock County,
- To E. G. Foster, Washington, D.C. to lay an underground cable under Route 25, for electric light and telephone service to residence of Mrs. Foster,
- To E. W. Herabberger, Leray, Virginia, to erect four telephone poles along Route 21 between Leray and Sperryville,
- To James E. Martin, Washington, D.C. to lay a $\frac{3}{4}$ " water line and 6" sewer line along Route 251, Arlington County,
- To McKesson Land Corporation, Petersburg, Virginia, to erect three or four electric light poles along Route 35 east of Petersburg,
- To Town of Middletown, to lay a 4" sidewalk on east side of Route 33 from School House to Reliance Road Corner,
- To Old Dominion Power Company, Norton, Virginia, to erect 11 poles along Route 11 at Norton,
- To Melvin D. Powell, Fredericksburg, Virginia, to construct a concrete apron in front of filling station to connect Routes 31 and 312, Spotsylvania Co.,
- To H. Ward Randolph, Richmond, Virginia, to lay a water pipe across and along Route 19 at Stratford Crescent, Henrico County,
- To A. A. Rowland, Williamsburg, Virginia, to lay a 15" pipe in ditch parallel to Route 39, one mile south of Marge, to provide entrance to filling station
- To Virginia Railway & Power Company, Richmond, Virginia, to string wires across Route 35 at intersection of Aquia Street near Petersburg, Virginia.
- To Virginia Railway & Power Company, Richmond, Virginia, to string wires across Route 10 between Isle of Wight and Petersburg, Prince George County,
- To Virginia Western Power Company, Clifton Forge, Virginia, to cross Route 14 with wires three times between Longdale Furnace and Clifton Forge,
- To Virginia Western Power Company, Clifton Forge, Virginia, to cross Route 14 four times with wires between Gallagher and West Virginia Line,

To Charlie Winston, Radensville, Virginia, to level ground in front of store on Route 321, Goochland County,

To Wythe Mutual Telephone Company, Wytheville, Virginia, to erect 21 poles along Route 15 about one mile west of Jackson Ferry, Wythe County,

To Town of Woodstock to cross State Highway No. 331 at two points with 8" C.I. pipe.

Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Huff, that Permit #512, issued The Town of Ashland on September 8th, 1924, to construct sidewalks in said town, be cancelled, as said work was never done. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Sprout, seconded by Mr. Massie, that permit #565 issued The Virginian Railway Company on January 29th, 1925, to construct a transmission line across Route 10 just west of Salem, be cancelled as said line is not to be constructed. Motion Carried.

Moved by Mr. Huff, seconded by Mr. Truetum, that Permit #587 issued The Town of Woodstock, on July 24, 1925, to lay a water main along Routes 33 and 331, be cancelled as the town has made other arrangements. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Huff, that the request of the Courthouse Garage, Fairfax, Virginia, for permission to construct and maintain a gas pump on Route 21, be denied, as recommended by the District Engineer. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Huff, seconded by Mr. Sprout, that the State Highway Commission reject the request of the Chesapeake and Potomac Telephone Company to cut and trim trees along Route 10 between Radford and Wytheville in order to erect telephone poles as the Commission is of the opinion that it has not the right to grant permission to any person or corporation to cut or trim these trees without the consent of the property owner. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Sprout, seconded by Mr. Huff, that the request of the Alexandria Suburban Motor Vehicle Company to reconsider the action taken by the Commission at their last meeting rejecting parking space privileges in the town of Fairfax, be turned down, and said action confirmed, as it is the opinion of the Commission that it has no right to set aside any portion of a public road right of way for the exclusive use of any person or persons. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Sprout, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the request of Mr. Wilson H. Parr, that the Commission reconsider the action taken at their last meeting offering Mr. Frank Ballenger \$400.00 in payment of barn which was burned, and grant him \$450.00 instead, be rejected as the Commission is of the opinion that the \$400.00 is a fair offer for the damage done the old building. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Sprout, that the State Highway Commission endorse the request of North Carolina to add a section of Route 18 from the North Carolina Line north via South Boston to Halifax, thence over Route 12 from Halifax to near Wylliesburg and thence over Route 32 to Berkerville, and also the section of Route 32 leading from the North Carolina Line via Clarksville to Route 324, thence over Route 324 to Boydton and thence over Route 12 to South Hill, to the Interstate and Transcontinental Highways, heretofore designated by the Joint Committee of the U.S. Government. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Sprout, seconded by Mr. Huff, that the agreement between the State and the City of Norfolk, whereby the State was to advance \$3750.00 and the City to guarantee the sum of \$1250.00 to be paid by Princess Anne County and whereas, the cost of improving the section of road leading to the State Rifle Range from State Highway No. 10 was only \$4400.00 and as this improvement

was made for the needs of the National Guard of the State, the State Highway Commission hereby relieves the City of Norfolk and the County of Princess Anne from their obligation. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Truxton, seconded by Mr. Sprout, that the Commission anticipate \$57,000.00 from funds coming available for road construction during 1926, for the completion of Route 121, Smith's Ferry to North Carolina line. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Huff, seconded by Mr. Sprout, that the Chairman be instructed to advertise for hearings on the Allocation of funds and the distribution of the $2\frac{1}{4}$ mileage to the various districts, to be held as follows:

Moved by Mr. Huff, seconded by Mr. Sproul, that it is the judgment of the Commission that it will be for the best interest of the State that the Robertson Act be repealed and that the Commission be empowered to refund the loans coming due at the end of four years, over a limited period of years.
 Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Sproul, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the Chairmen be authorized to take up with the District Commissioners and see if sufficient funds cannot be included in the District Budget to build the two miles of road through the District property at Ocequana. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Sproul, seconded by Mr. Truxton, that if a satisfactory route can be secured leading out of Shenandoah City; the line known as the high route crossing over the N.W. Railroad tracks be adopted. Motion carried.

Middle Rock Mine No. 47
Dunton Mining Co.

Moved by Mr. Truxton, seconded by Mr. Spraul, that the location of the proposed bridge across the Rappahannock River be at Tappahannock, provided it does not cost more than from \$20,000.00 to \$30,000.00 more than at some other point within a reasonable distance from Tappahannock. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Huff, seconded by Mr. Masie, that the Chairman be authorized to return to Giles County the \$50,000.00 advanced under the Robertson Act if satisfactory arrangements cannot be made for rights of way. If a satisfactory arrangement can be made for rights of way on the section from Marrows towards Pearisburg for about two and one-half miles, then to expend the funds on this section proceeding with the convict force now in this county. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Truxton, seconded by Mr. Masie, that the Chairman be authorized to delay the construction of an overhead crossing at Narrows, Va., on State Highway No. 103, until such time as funds are available for this purpose and that the N.W. Railway Company be requested to allow a crossing at grade until such time as we can join them in the construction of an overhead bridge. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Truxton, seconded by Mr. Masie, that the Commission Anticipate \$15,000.00 of the construction funds available during 1926 to complete the stretch of road between Parkaley to the Mine House, on State Highway No. 343. Motion carried.

There being no further business, the Commission adjourned subject to the call of the Chairman.
