MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE STATE HIGHWAY
COMMISSION OF VIRGINIA, HELD AT APPOMATTOX
AND HOLLOWAY, VIRGINIA, OCTOBER 21st, 1926.

On the morning of October 21st, 1926, Commissioners Shirley, Mason, and Sproul met in Richmond and proceeded to Appomattox Court House where they were joined by Commissioner Gilmer, and shortly after eleven o'clock a hearing was given to all present in accordance with public notice, concerning the closing of certain grade crossings of State Highway No. 10, and the Norfolk & Western Railroad tracks between Pamplin and Appomattox.

Chairman Shirley did not sit as a member of the Commission or vote, but represented the Department before the Commission in regards to these changes.

After the meeting in Appomattox the Commission proceeded to Holloway Court House where another public hearing was given in regards to closing certain grade crossings and making other changes in Route 10 where it crossed the Norfolk & Western Railroad between Petersburg and Blackstone, the three Commissioners above sitting as a body and the Chairman appearing as the representative of the Department.

After this meeting the Commission returned to Richmond where the meeting adjourned.
