

Minutes of the Meeting of the State
Highway Commission of Virginia,
Held in Richmond, October 4,
1936.

On the morning of October 4th, the State Highway Commission, consisting of Messrs. H. G. Shirley, Wade H. Massie, Secretary, S. W. Rawls, J. F. Wysor and Kenneth N. Gilpin, met in their office, State Office Building, Richmond, Virginia.

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman.

Moved by Mr. Wysor, seconded by Mr. Rawls, that the minutes of the meeting of September 7th be approved. Motion carried.

Mr. H. W. Southall of Prince George, Va., and Mr. F. L. Wyche, appeared before the Commission concerning the question of right of way on Route 460, (old Route 52) in Disputanta, asking the removal of his dwelling back from edge of the right of way.

Moved by Mr. Rawls, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that the Commission move the house of Mr. H. W. Southall back from the right of way of Route 460 in Disputanta provided sufficient right of way will be furnished for an 80 ft. width, 40 ft. from the center line on either side thereof. Motion carried.

Mr. G. M. Waugh, of Unionville, Judge Browning, Mr. Clifton C. Huns, representing supervisor E. S. Knighton, Mr. R. M. Waugh, Superintendent of Schools D. N. Davidson, Rev. E. V. Peyton, Mr. Green and several other gentlemen appeared before the Commission and requested an allocation for the construction of Route 48 from the Rapidan River over to Unionville School in Orange County.

Senator Booker, Senator Tuck, Judge Hudgins, Mr. Berkeley D. Adams, Mr. Wilbur C. Hall, Mr. R. E. Bureau, Colonel Roberts and several other gentlemen appeared before the Commission and requested the construction of a bridge over the Staunton River at the entrance to Staunton River Park.

Moved by Mr. Wysor, seconded by Mr. Massie, that ordinance having been passed by the Town of Port Royal turning over Route 207, and the Town of Colonial Beach turning over Route 205Y for maintenance, that the Commission take over these Routes for a width of 30 ft. and maintain the same. Motion carried.
