

Minutes of the Meeting of the State Highway
Commission of Virginia, Held in
Richmond, October 18, 1938.

On the morning of October 18th, the State Highway Commission, consisting of Messrs. H. G. Shirley, Wade H. Massie, Secretary, E. W. Rawls, J. F. Wyszor and Kenneth N. Gilpin, met in their office, State Office Building, Richmond, Virginia.

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman.

Moved by Mr. Wyszor, seconded by Mr. Rawls, that the minutes of the meeting of September 14th be approved. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Rawls, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the Commission allocate to the City of Portsmouth for the year 1938-1940, the \$500.00 per mile construction fund, to be expended on Gosport Road, between 7th and Green Streets. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Wyszor, seconded by Mr. Rawls, that the Commission have no objection to the Conservation Commission having an act passed placing approximately 20 miles of main roads in the various State Parks into the Highway System and under the supervision of the State Highway Commission. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Wyszor, seconded by Mr. Gilpin, that the claim of James Millirona for damage to his well caused by blasting during construction on Route 801 in Pulaski County, be paid in the amount of \$150.00, the cost to drill a new well. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Rawls, seconded by Mr. Wyszor, that the Commission permit service connections to be made by telephone and electric light companies, provided the current does not exceed 240v, under a blanket permit; to be followed up by report to the District Engineer in each District for crossovers, so made, within ten days after the crossings are made. The permit to show locations, etc. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Wyszor, seconded by Mr. Rawls, that on all special permits issued, the speed limit not exceed 35 miles an hour and this to be so stated on the permit. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Gilpin, that permit No. 12318, Arlington County, Route 244, requested by the Virginia Public Service Company to erect a pole line and cut trees on Route 244 be granted. Messrs. Shirley, Wyszor and Rawls voting nay, Messrs. Massie and Gilpin voting yes. Motion lost.

RESOLUTION ORDERING THE FILING OF BIDS

WHEREAS, pursuant to advertisement, bids for the Window Shades and Venetian Blinds in the Central Highway Office Building have been filed by the following Bidders;

RESOLUTION AWARDED CONTRACT

WHEREAS, Carneal, Johnston and Wright, Consulting Architects and Engineers, pursuant to a Resolution heretofore adopted, have tabulated and considered all bids heretofore received for the Window Shades and Venetian Blinds in the Central Highway Office Building and have duly made their recommendations to this Commission, and it appearing from said recommendations and report that Thalhimer Brothers, Inc., Richmond, Virginia, is the lowest and best Bidder for the furnishing of Window Shades and Venetian Blinds in the Central Highway Office Building, in the sum of \$5540.60, and that this Commission, after considering said report and recommendations, and all bids heretofore filed, finds that the bid of Thalhimer Brothers, Inc., is the lowest and best bid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE STATE HIGHWAY COMMISSION OF VIRGINIA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the bid of Thalhimer Brothers, Inc. for the Window Shades and Venetian Blinds in the Central Highway Office Building, in the sum of \$5540.60; is hereby accepted, determined and declared to be the lowest and best bid, however, this award shall not be effective until the awardee shall have been notified in writing by the Architects of the State Highway Commission of such award. That upon the awardee being so notified in writing a contract for the construction of said work, as heretofore prescribed by the plans, specifications and contract documents, shall be forthwith executed for said construction.

Moved by Mr. Wynn, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the Commission lease to Mr. W. H. Sable, of Buark, Virginia, for \$1.00 a year the wharf site at Buark, in Middlesex County, consisting of about half an acre of land that was given to the county for storage purposes and a wharf, the same having come under control of the Highway Department when the secondary roads were turned over. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Rawls, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the Chairman be authorized to sign agreement agreeing to the 25 foot set back on the Lee Boulevard, Route 711, in accordance with Arlington County zoning. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Rawls, that whereas the law under which the location of a section of road leading from the Shenandoah River via Waterloo to near the Frederick County line, in Clarke and Frederick Counties has been questioned, and whereas the law will come before the Courts for adjudication, now therefore the State Highway Commission tentatively adds this section, 9.5 miles, to the State Highway System, under Chapter 172, Section 5B, Act of March 17, 1938. In case the law is declared invalid the tentative addition immediately becomes effective and permanent, but if the validity of the law is upheld, the action of the Commission in making this addition becomes null and void.
