NOW, THEREFORE, in accordance with the provisions of Section 33-76.6 of the 1950 Code of Virginia as smended, the conveyance of the said land so certified to the Virginia Electric and Fower Company at a price deemed satisfactory by the State Right of Way Engineer is hereby approved, together with an essenset of ingress and egrase along and adjacent to the Railroad right of way line from eald Van Dorn Street to said area to be conveyed to the Virginia Electric and Power Company, and the State Bighway Commissioner is haraby authorized to execute a dead in the same of the Commonwealth conveying some without warranty and subject to such conditions or restrictions as he may does requisite. Motion carried.

Mr. J. T. Timmons, Managing Director of Tidemater Automobile Association, complimented the Commission on having sponsored the right of way advance fund.

The chairman stated the next weeting of the Counission would be held on November 18, 1965, at 10 A.M.
