WHEREAS, on July 17, 1997, the Commonwealth Transportation Board allocated \$297,000 of the 1997-98 Fiscal Year Industrial, Airport and Rail Access Funds to provide adequate access to the Ply-Mould Corporation, located in the Louisa County Industrial Air Park, Project 0797-054-216, N501; and

WHEREAS, the Director of the Department of Conservation and Recreation has recommended the construction of the aforementioned access road.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that \$193,000 from the 1997-98 Fiscal Year Recreational Access Fund be allocated to construct the access road to The Cultural Arts Center at Glen Allen, Project 9999-043-182, M501, contingent upon:

- all necessary right of way, environmental assessments, and utility adjustments being provided at no cost to the Recreational Access Fund; and
- the payment of all ineligible project costs and all eligible project costs in excess of \$193,000 from sources other than the Recreational Access Fund.
