MINUTES OF THE RESTING OF THE STATE
RIGHTAY COMMISSION HELD AT GRANGS, HARRISCHBURG,
AND RICHTOND, VIRGINIA, AND AN INSPROVICE TRIP,
NOVEMBER 9TH, 10TH, 11TH AND 12TH,

1921.

The State Highway Commission, with all members in attendance, namely; Wade H. Maguie, Chairman, Henry P. Beck, Secretary, James A. Bear, J. W. Davie, and Horace Hardaway, assembled at the Hotel Heverley in Staumton, Virginia on Tuesday evening, Hovember Sth. 1921, and on Wednesday morning, Hovember 9th, accompanied by George P. Goleman, Highway Commissioner, and the local road officials, proceeded in automobiles from Staumton to Hot Surings, via Churchville, Hount Ellisti, Craigeville, Goshen and Milboro, returning to Staumton, via Houtes 17 and 9.

From Staunton the Commission proceeded to Harrisonburg, where they remained for the night.

At Harrisonburg on Thursday magning, howenber 19th, 1921, a number of officials of Page and Rockingham Counties, and representative elimens of these two Counties, not the Highway Commission and presented the road situation in this community, and at the conclusion of the hearing, accompanies the Commission on a tour of the roads in this neighborhood, leaving Marrisonburg and proceeding over

Route 17 to Penn Laird and Elkton. From Elkton the Commission proceeded over the proposed addition to the State Highway System from Elkton to Luray, via Stanley, going as far north as Luray.

From Lursy the Commission returned to Stanley where they embarked in Ford care and presented over the Blue Ridge via Milan's Cap to Syria.

Pron Syria the Commission proceeded over Route 16 to Madison C.H.; thence on to Orange, where the might was spent.

On Thursday evening, November 10th, 1921,
the State Highway Consission, with all members in attendadance,
namely) Yade H. Massie, Chairman, Henry P. Book, Secretary,
Jenes A. Bear, Y. W. Davie, and Horace Hardaway, met in
the Hotel at Orange for the transaction of general Musiness.

Hr. Hear moved that the Commission sustain the action of Righmay Commissioner Colemns in locating that portion of Route ] between Lexington and Natural Swidge, via Buffalo Forge, and on roll this motion was rejected by a vote of two ayes to three nose, as follows: Ayes! Massis and Bear! Hose: Book, Davie and Hardaway.

On motion of Mr. Davie the Rockbridge contest

After careful consideration, the Highway Commission decides that the appeal of the Board of Supervisors of Rockbridge County, and also the appeal of certain fresholders of Roskbridge County, protecting against the location of that portion of Route He. 3, between Lexington and Matural Bridge, via Buffalo Forge, as determined by the Highway Commissioner, George P. Coleman, are quetnined, and the Highway Commission hereby adopts as the permanent location of Route He. 3, between Lexington and Matural Bridge, the middle, or Elliott Hill, or Fancy Hill Boute, and the Highway Commissioner is hereby directed to follow this general route in the location of this portion of Route Me. 3.

On motion of Mr. Hardaway the Commission entered the following order in the South County contest, Mr. Davis being excused from voting at his request.

Percentage of Scott County, protecting against the location of that portion of Route Ho. 10, between Special Percent and Stickleyville Gap, via Pattonsville; as made by George P. Colaman, State Highway Commissioner, the State Highway Commissioner, the State Highway Commission rejects the said appeal, and hereby sustains and adopts as the permanent location for Route Ho. 10 between Special Percent Attalleyville Gap, the location as made by the State Highway Commissioner, and the Highway Commissioner is hereby directed to follow this general route in the location of this portion of Route Mo. 10.

Er, Bear moved a reconsideration of the Commission's order in the Lexington-Longdale (Route 14) contest, on the grounds that no survey had been unde of the Kerr's Creek Route, and for the further reason that only three members of the Commission had soted at the hearing.

The Commission request to reconsider the matter by the following vote: Ayes, two, Bear and Davie; Nose; three, Massie, Book and Hardaway.

On motion of Mr. Near the Secretary was instructed to write to T. W. Ourpor, Clerk of the Cirquit Court of Franklin County, and to accordin from him when he received the official notification of the location of Reute Mc. 3 from Hoanake to Rocky Hount, via Boomes Mill, from Highway Commissioner Coleman, and If he has notified the local road officials, of the receipt and contents of the Highway Commissioner's notification, and also to furnish the Highway Commission with a copy of the Highway

The Commission than adjourned to meet in Richmond on Friday, Movember 11th, 1921, Mr. Bear leaving the Commission at Orange for his home in Resmoke on account of the serious illness of his mother.

The Commission left Orange on Friday morning, November 11th, 1921, for Richmond, proceeding by automobile over Route 2 to Waldrep, thence over Route 9 to Negro Foot, thence over Route 1 to Richmond,

Ch Friday afternoon, Hovember lith, the State Highway Commission with Wade H. Mannis, Chairman, Henry P. Beck, Secretary, F. Davie, and Hornes Hardaway, in attendedness, met in the rooms of the Highway Department, 116 South Third Street. Hr. Bear was absent on account of the death of his mother.

On motion of Mr. Hardeway, the minutes of the meetings of October 5, 6, 7, and 8th, and October 20th and 21st, 1921, were read and approved, and the Chairman and Secretary authorized to sign the same as correct.

On motion of My. Davie the appeal of cortain of timens and freshelders of Pittaylvania County, protecting against the location of that portion of House No. 14 between Chatham and Altavista, as determined by Highway Commissioner Coleman, was set for inspection and hearing on Tuesday November 22, 1921, at Altavista, and S. S. Hurt, Clerk, was immediately notified of this action.

On motion of Mr. Hardamay, the Secretary was authorized to sign and deliver the following letter to Henorable Roland E. Chase:

"In regard to the advancement of funds from Robinson District of Wise County for the building of that portion of Route Ro. 11, from the Rentucky State Line east towards Chintwood, I bug to advise that I am instricted by the gighway Commission to state that if the Board of Supervisors, or other parties, will loan to the Highway Commission, sufficient funds therefor, the Commission will have the Highway Department locate and grade, or build the road, commending with the Kentucky State Line, as for towards Chintwood as the funds advanced will carry it.

Please advice us how much you can furnish for this project, and the proper agreements will be made up and forwarded to you. It seems advisable to the Commission that not less than \$60,000 should be loaned to take care of the grade from the Kentucky State Line for the first three or four miles. If this money is loaned under the law provided for same, the Commission will return it to the parties advancing it, as the same is allocated to this project, but without interest.

On motion of Mr. Davie, the additional sum of \$30,000 was allocated out of the one-third 1922 automobile tax to the Lynchburg-Bustburg Bond, State Highway No. 14, in order to provide sufficient fundate occupiete the construction on this project.

Hr. C. P. Coleman, Highway Consissioner, referred to the State Highway Consission, a letter from Heanra, F. R. Holting & Company, dated October 28th, 1921, submitting a revised advedule for payments on the Louise County Bond Issue of \$200,000, advanced by the Board of Supervisors of Leuise County, for the countries of a portion of Route No. 9 in Louise County.

On motion of Mr. Davie, the schedule as set out in y. 4. Holting & Company's letter was accepted and the Commissioner instructed to so advise them.

On motion of Wr. Hardaway the following resolutions, regarding the acquisition of rights of way in various sections of the State by condemnation, were adopted:
