The State Highway Commission met at Luray, Virginia,
1:00 P.M. on November 13th, 1923, those being present were Messrs.
H. G. Shirley, Chairman, Wade H. Massie, Secretary, R. K. Sanders,
and H. B. Sproul, and held a hearing on the location of the road
from Luray to Elkton.

After this hearing the Commission made inspection of
the routes in question, then proceeded to Staunton where they
spent the night.

On the morning of the 14th, Commissioners Shirley and
Massie proceeded to Lexington and made an inspection of the Kerr
Creek and Colliertown Routes and then returned and made an in-
spection of the road between Lexington and Staunton.
