MINUTES OF THE MESTING OF THE STATE HIGHWAY COMMISSION OF VIRGINIA, HELD NOVEMBER 18th, 1987.

On the morning of November 18th, 1927, in company with the Governor, Complesioners Shirley, Sproul, and Massie, left Richmond and proceeded by motor to Paramille, Virginia, where they attended the regional road mosting.

Enroute a meeting of the Commission was held and the following business transmoted:

Noved by Mr. Sproul, seconded by Mr. Massis, that the contract for the construction of Project 8-498C, Route 21, 1.561 Miles East of Washington, Virginia to .97 Miles East of Washington, be awarded to the low bidder, Contral Sometraction Company, Victoria, Virginia, at their bid of \$12,687.52, setting maids 10% additional to cover the cost of engineering and additional work and \$906.40 for Guard Sail, making a total of approximately \$15,000.00 chargeable to this Project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, escended by Mr. Shirley, that the contract for the construction of Project 3831, Route 14, Covington - Grove, be awarded to the low bidder, Central Construction Company, Victoria, Virginia, at their bid of \$26,126.30 setting mide 16% additional to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, \$800.00 for Detours and \$4,422.66 for Guard Rail, making a total of approximately \$87,000.00 chargeable to this Project. Motion carried.

Hoved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by "r. Sproul, that the bid on Route 33, Project 3-4360E, .908 Miles North of Ridgeway to Ridgeway, be rejected as it was above the approximate estimate and the only bid received, and that the Chief Engineer be instructed to readvertice same. Motion curried.

Minate Peck Start Rp. 66-7 Errorit Wolder Co. Noved by Mr. Sproal, seconded by Mr. Massis, that the contract for the construction of Project 503, Route 28, Rapiden River North and South, be awarded to the low bidder, Hall and Mitchell, Keswick, Virginia, at their bid of 67,105.60, setting and 10% additional to ever the cost of engineering and additional work, \$522.50 for Detours, and 31,161.04 for Guard Hall, making a total of approximately \$10,000.00 chargeable to this Project. Metics carried.

Hoved by Mr. Massis, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that the contract for the construction of Project 2660IK, Route 10, 4 Miles East of Blackstone to 2.2 Miles East of Blackstone, be awarded to the low hidder, 0. 5. Luck and Some, Inc. Richmond, Virginia, at their bid of \$22,064.65, cetting 10% additional saide to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, \$4,315.20 for Guard Rail, and \$12,172.50 for Surface Treatment, making a total of approximately \$42,000.00 chargeable to this Project. Notice carried.
