MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE STATE  
HIGHWAY COMMISSION OF VIRGINIA, HELD  
NOVEMBER 18th, 1927.

On the morning of November 18th, 1927, in company with the Governor, Commissioners Shirley, Sproul, and Massie, left Richmond and proceeded by motor to Farmville, Virginia, where they attended the regional road meeting.

Enroute a meeting of the Commission was held and the following business transacted:

Moved by Mr. Sproul, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the contract for the construction of Project S-4220, Route 21, 1.561 Miles East of Washington, Virginia to .97 Miles East of Washington, be awarded to the low bidder, Central Construction Company, Victoria, Virginia, at their bid of \$12,687.32, setting aside 10% additional to cover the cost of engineering and additional work and \$906.40 for Guard Rail, making a total of approximately \$15,000.00 chargeable to this Project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that the contract for the construction of Project 393A, Route 14, Covington - Crows, be awarded to the low bidder, Central Construction Company, Victoria, Virginia, at their bid of \$28,124.20 setting aside 10% additional to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, \$800.00 for Detours and \$4,422.66 for Guard Rail, making a total of approximately \$37,000.00 chargeable to this Project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Sproul, that the bid on Route 33, Project S-4260E, .904 Miles North of Ridgeway to Ridgeway, be rejected as it was above the approximate estimate and the only bid received, and that the Chief Engineer be instructed to readvertise same. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Spraul, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the contract for the construction of Project 503, Route 28, Rapidan River North and South, be awarded to the low bidder, Hall and Mitchell, Keewick, Virginia, at their bid of \$7,293.00, setting aside 10% additional to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, \$522.50 for Detours, and \$1,151.04 for Guard Rail, making a total of approximately \$10,000.00 chargeable to this Project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that the contract for the construction of Project 3560IK, Route 10, 4 Miles East of Blackstone to 2.2 Miles East of Blackstone, be awarded to the low bidder, G. S. Luck and Sons, Inc. Richmond, Virginia, at their bid of \$22,944.85, setting 10% additional aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, \$4,315.20 for Guard Rail, and \$12,172.50 for Surface Treatment, making a total of approximately \$42,000.00 chargeable to this Project. Motion carried.

After the meeting the Commission returned to Richmond where they adjourned, subject to the call of the Commissioners.
