MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE STATE
HIGHWAY COMMISSION OF VIRGINIA, IN
RICHMOND, VIRGINIA, NOVEMBER 18, 1929.

On the morning of November 18, 1929, the State Highway Commission consisting of Messrs. H. G. Shirley, Commissioner, Wade H. Massie, Secretary, L. Walka Truxton, H. G. Gilmer, and Senator W. H. East, met at their office, State Office Building, Richmond, Virginia.

The meeting was called to order by the Commissioner.

Mr. Wilbur G. Hall, and others representing the Washington and Old Dominion Railway Company and the Cherry Smash Plant at Rosslyn, Virginia, came before the Commission in regard to the request for a permit to construct a spur track across Route 21 in Rosslyn to serve the Cherry Smash Plant. It was stated that the Railway Company would agree to any reasonable requirements, confining operations between the hours when traffic on the highway was a minimum and also if the Commission deemed it necessary have a flagman during the operations. They also claimed that the highway had been placed 9.75 feet on the property of the Cherry Smash Plant at this point.

They were advised that the Commission would give careful consideration to their request.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Senator East, that the minutes of the meetings of the Commission held in Richmond, September 15th and October 9th, 1929, be approved. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Truxton, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that the Commission confirm the award of contract for the construction of Route 12, Project R-566-E, West of Lawrenceville-Brunswick County Line, to the low bidder, W. H. Clark and company, Charlottesville, Virginia, at their bid of \$10,140.80, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work and \$5,730.00 for Surface Treatment, making a total of approximately \$17,000.00 chargeable to this Project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the Commission confirm the award of contract for the construction of Route 14, Project R-597-A, Balcony Falls-Suena Vista, to the low bidder, J. J. Batterhill & Son, Virginina, at their bid of \$78,862.82, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$87,000.00 chargeable to this Project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that the Commission confirm the award of contract for the construction of Route 10, Project R-266-E of Roanoke - Roanoke, to the low bidder, Pendleton Construction Company, Wytheville, Virginia, at their bid of \$56,486.20 and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, increasing the width of the bituminous macadam to 20', making a total of approximately \$65,000.00 chargeable to this Project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. East, that the Commission confirm the award of contract for the construction of Route 37, Project S-593-EH&2, Work at Winchester and Berryville, to the low bidder, Scholz Brothers, Inc., Alderson, West, Virginia, at their bid of \$37,373.75 and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, \$2,886.00 for Surface Treatment, \$700.00 for Detours and \$692.12 for Guard Rail, making a total of approximately \$46,000.00 chargeable to this Project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. East, seconded by Mr. Truxton, that the Commission confirm the award of contract for the construction of Route 407, Project S-480-EV, Hopewell-Intersection of Route 10, to the low bidder, Southeastern Construction Company, Petersburg, Virginia, at their bid of \$13,050.00 and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, \$1,000.00 for Overhaul, and \$13,392.00 for Surface Treatment, making a total of approximately \$39,000.00 chargeable to this Project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Truxton, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that the Commission confirm the award of contract for the construction of Route 39, Project S-356-GDEGM, Newport News-Lee Hall, to the low bidder, G. Y. Carpenter, Chester, Virginia, at his bid of \$108,087.26 and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$119,000.00 chargeable to this Project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the Commission confirm the award of contract for the construction of Route 18, Project R-552, Bridge over Staunton River at Brockmeal, to the low bidder, A. N. Campbell & Co., Lynchburg, Va. at their bid of \$84,568.50 and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$93,000.00 chargeable to this Project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that the Commission confirm the award of contract for the construction of Route 10, Project S-497-EL, Radford - Dublin, to the low bidder, Atlantic Refining Company, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, at their bid of \$5,340.00 and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$6,000.00 chargeable to this Project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. East, that the Commission confirm the award of contract for the construction of Route 38, Project R-417-B, Bridge over Mount Landing Creek near Dappahamnock, to the low bidder, J. S. Bowers, Whiteville, N.C. at his bid of \$23,209.35 and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$26,000.00 chargeable to this Project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that the bid on Project S-143-B2, Route 10, Approaches to Big Otter River Bridge, be rejected as being too high and that the work be done by the State. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Truxton, that the contract for the construction of four bridges over Cove Creek, Route 10, Project R-528-S1,2, 3,4, be awarded to the low bidder, Alley Construction Company, Bristol, Virginia

at their bid of \$22,251.71 and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$25,000.00 chargeable to this Project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Truxton, that the contract for the construction of Route 11, Project F-195-B, Bridge over Powell River, be awarded to the low bidder, Alley Construction Company, Bristol, Virginia, at their bid of \$10,802.95, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$12,000.00 chargeable to this Project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Truxton, seconded by Senator East, that the contract for the construction of Route 13, Project F-586-S1, Bridge over Willis River, be awarded to the low bidder, Roanoke Iron and Bridge Works, Inc., Roanoke, Virginia, at their bid of \$6,306.17, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$7,000 chargeable to this Project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Truxton, that the contract for the construction of Route 31, Project S-588-C, D.C. Line - 1.9 Miles South, be awarded to the low bidder, John H. Cleott, Clarendon, Virginia, on Sheet Asphalt, at his bid of \$77,795.24 and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, and \$1,100.00 for Detours, making a total of approximately \$87,000.00 chargeable to this Project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Truxton, that the location of Route 14 north of Vanville be adopted on the direct line surveyed. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that no action be taken in regard to the request of the Town of Blackstone to permanently locate Route 10 between Blackstone and Nottoway on the north side of the Norfolk & Western tracks. Motion carried.

A delegation from Newport News and vicinity appeared before the Commission in regard to an additional road from Lee Hall to Newport News. They stated that they realized it would take a number of years to get it included under the 2½% Clause and wanted to get an expression from the State Highway Commission as to whether they would support a bill in the legislature making this addition.

Moved by Mr. East, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the Commission cooperate with the Town of Covington to the extent of paying one-half of the \$3,000.00 requested on the Bridge over Jackson River at Covington. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that the request of the Virginia State Chamber of Commerce for 50,000 additional maps, be granted. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Truxton, seconded by Mr. East, that the following permits be granted under the Rules and Regulations of the Commission:

Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Bassie, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that the Seaboard Air Line Railway Company be notified that the Commission cannot see its way clear to pay any portion of the cost of the undergrade crossing on Route 407 as they do not believe they have a legal right to do so. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the Commission adopt the location of Route 10 through the Betts Property in Smithfield and proceed immediately with the construction of the Bridge over Fagan River. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. East, that permit be granted the Public Telephone Corporation of Richmond, Virginia, to place 400 poles along Route 406 from intersection of Route 20 to Tobaccoville, thence along Route 13 to intersection of Route 45, provided said poles are placed against the property line. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Truxton, that Permit #6229, issued to Cushman Plumbing Company, New Market, Virginia, October 1, 1929 be cancelled as the work was never done and plans have been changed. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that inasmuch as the low bidder, Walters and Prater, Dandridge, Tennessee, did not sign their contract for the construction of Route 17, Project R-583, Elkton-Tay of Mountain, that their check for \$1,000.00 be forfeited and the contract awarded to the second low bidder, at his bid. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that the request of the contractor, Pace Construction Company, on Route 10, Project 468-CB, West of Weston-East of Roanoke, for \$1206.50 for rebuilding a section of base course and \$620.00 liquidated damages, be turned down, as per recommendation of Chief Engineer Mullens. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that the contractor, G. S. Luck and Sons, on Route 54, Project 505, Leesburg-Hamilton, be returned \$450.00 liquidated damages, as per recommendation of Chief Engineer Mullens. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. East that the Washington and Old Dominion Railway Company, Washington, D.C. and the Cherry Smash Company, Rosslyn, Virginia, be granted a permit to cross Route 21 at Rosslyn, Virginia, with a spur track to serve the Cherry Smash Plant, with the following provisions:

1. That a deed for the right of way at this point, claimed by the Cherry Smash Company, be given the State;
 2. That operations shall be between the hours of 12 midnight and 5:00 A.M.
 3. Traffic on the highway not to be blocked more than two minutes at any one time;
 4. Trains to come to stop before crossing highway;
 5. Highway traffic to be protected by flagmen;
 6. If the surface of the road is widened in the future that proper approach to rails and between tracks will be constructed by said company.
- Motion carried. Mr. Truxton voting no.

Moved by Mr. East, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that in keeping with their former policy the Commission cannot recommend to the Legislature that any special road or roads be taken into the State Highway System. Motion carried. Mr. Truxton voting No.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that the Commissioner be authorized to spend \$11,375.00 on Route 112, Project 464-R, based on estimate of Mr. R. P. Ellison, to extend the work to Adria. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Truxton, that the Commissioner be authorized to transfer the various over-runs and under-runs in the Bristol District so as to off-set each other as far as they will. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that the Commissioner be authorized to transfer the various over-runs and under-runs in the Lynchburg District so as to off-set each other as far as possible. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Truxton, seconded by Mr. East, that the Commissioner be authorized to make certain transfers in the Richmond District to off-set the over-runs from under-runs as far as possible. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Truxton, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that the Commissioner be authorized to make certain transfers in the Suffolk District to off-set the over-runs from under-runs as far as possible. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. East, that the Commissioner be authorized to make certain transfers in the Fredericksburg District to off-set the over-runs from under-runs as far as possible. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Truxton, that the Commissioner be authorized to make certain transfers in the Culpeper District to off-set the over-runs from under-runs as far as possible. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. East, that the Commissioner be authorized to make certain transfers in the Staunton District to off-set the over-runs from under-runs as far as possible. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Truxton, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that negotiations be immediately taken up with the Virginian Railway Company looking forward to the elimination of the grade crossing on Route 35 at Sebrell, preparing plans for that purpose. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Truxton, that the following tentative allocation of funds be made and that public hearings be held at the time and places given below:
