

Minutes of the Meeting of the State Highway  
Commission of Virginia, Held in  
Richmond, November 9, 1937.

On the morning of November 9th, the State Highway Commission, consisting of Messrs. H. G. Shirley, Wade H. Massie, Secretary, Wm. H. East, S. W. Rawls and J. P. Wyser, met in their office, State Office Building, Richmond, Virginia

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Rawls, that the minutes of the meeting of September 23rd be approved. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Rawls, that the \$500.00 per mile construction fund for 1937-38 be approved for the City of Charlottesville, to be expended on additional surfacing on West Main Street, Route 250. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. East, that the \$500.00 per mile construction fund for 1937-38 be approved for the City of Winchester, to be expended on paving Route 50. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Rawls, seconded by Mr. East, that the \$500.00 per mile construction fund for 1937-38 be approved for the City of Norfolk, to be expended on Route 299, the Toll Free Road. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Wyser, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the \$500.00 per mile construction fund for 1937-38 be approved for the Town of Vinton, to be expended on the section of Route 84 that is 40 ft. in width. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. East, seconded by Mr. Massie, that in accordance with Chapter 212, Section 1, Act approved March 19th, 1926, and upon recommendation of the Chairman, the following sections of Route 250 in Highland County are no longer necessary for use as a State highway and the same be abandoned upon opening of the new section in lieu thereof; Sections 1 to 10 inclusive shown on plat dated September 27, 1937, Project 1003D. Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Wyser, that the request of Mr. H. W. Poindexter and others that some work be done on old location of Route 220 between Bearcreek and Rocky Mount, be tabled. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Rawls, seconded by Mr. Wyser, that the work on Route 70, Project 1121, Dickenson-Russell County Line, be advertised and the matter of delaying the work be considered at that time. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. East, seconded by Mr. Rawls, that the Chairman be instructed to take up with the Young Men's Business Club of Palmyra the type of marker desired to be erected in the triangle at Dixie, and permit be granted to erect the same provided it is in compliance with the general rules and regulations. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Wyser, that at the request of the Mayor and City Council of Fredericksburg, project for constructing new bridge over the Rappahannock River above Fredericksburg, for which the Government made an appropriation of \$175,000.00 for flood damage, be temporarily dropped. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Rawls, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the collection of all claims be made wherever possible, and where the cost of collection is excessive conditions be reported to the Commission; also that the present claim against Don Harmon of \$8.00 be dropped. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Rawls, that the C&P Telephone Company of Va., be permitted to add 27 additional poles on present line between Charlottesville and Richmond, on Routes 250, 180, 49 and 4 to improve carrier operation and relieve crostalk. Motion carried.
