Minutes of the Meeting of the State Highway Commission of Virginia, and Inspection Trip in the Hampton Roads Area, November 15 and 14, 1942,

At the meeting of the State Highway Commission on September 16th, it was decided to hold an inspection trip in the Humpton Bonds area. In accordance with that understanding the following numbers of the Commission met at the Suffolk District Office at 9:00 A.M., Friday, November 18th: Messra, R. P. Barrow, Essett H. Feindester, S. W. Rawls, Secretary, J. B. Wampler, J. F. Wysor and J. A. Anderson.

Accompanying the Commission on the trip were Mr. Thos. H. MacDonald, Commissioner, Public Roads Administration, Mr. B. P. McRhorter, Semior Highway Engineer, Public Roads Administration; Mr. C. S. Mullen, Chief Engineer, Mrs T. F. Loughborough, Construction Engineer and Mr. J. M. Hagan, District Engineer, State Highway Department.

Mr. Goo, P. DeHardit joined the Commission that evening and a meeting was held at the Elliott Rotel, in Suffolk at 8:00 P.M. The following business was transcreted.

Moved by Mr. Nawls, seconded by Mr. Wysor, that the minutes of the September 15th meeting be approved, as sent out to the members. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Wysor, seconded by Mr. Poindarter, that the Commission confirm rejection of bid received September 24th on Project SN-FAS 699 AlW, AdW, Noute 168, NCL Newport News-5.5 Mi. M. MCL Newport News, the to excessive prices. Motion carried,

Moved by Mr. Wysor, seconded by Mr. Poindexter, that the Commission confirm award of contract for the construction of Project DA-RE 1411 A1, Intersection Route 17-1.5 Mig W. Route 17, to the bidder, W. H. Scott, Inc., Franklin, Ve., at his bid of \$121,566.06; that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work and \$10,000.00 for right of way, making a total of approximately \$145,700.00 chargeable to this project, subject to approval of the Public Heads Administration. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Wysor, seconded by Mr. Poladexter, that the Commission confirm award of contract for the construction of Project 25-FIP 1402 AM, Route 11, 4.1 Mi. H. Dublin-C.4 Mi. W. Dublin, to the low bidder, Pendleton Comstruction Corporation, Wytheville, Va., at their bid of \$412,217.01; that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work and \$180.00 for work by State Forces, making a total of approximately \$455,600.00 chargeable to this project. Additional funds required to be sharged against the 1948-1945 allocation to Glammar-West, Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Mysor, seconded by Mr. Poindexter, that the Commission confirm award of contract for the construction of Project SN-PAS 699 AlW, ANW, Boute 168, MQL Hemport News- 5.3 Miles North, to the low tidder, Heehler Bross, Highland Springs, Va., at their bid of \$439,119.45; that 10% additional be set saide to cover the cost of engineering and additional work and \$3,277,00 for work by the railroad, making a total of approximately \$486,300.00 charge-able to this project, subject to approval of the Public Roads Administration. Notion carried.

Moved by Mr. Mysor, seconded by Mr. Pointanter, that the Commission confirm award of contract for the construction of Project DA-WR 1263 H, Route 611, Intersection Route 1 at Pohick Church -0.6 Mi. S. Intersection Route 1, (Lorton Rifle Hange), to the low bidder, Blackwell Engineering and Construction Company, Warrenton, Va., at their bid of \$22,755.65, that 10% additional be set saide to cower the cost of engineering and additional work and \$1,500,00 for right of way, making a total of approximately \$26,500,00 chargeable to this project. Motion earnied,

Moved by Mr. Mysor, becomied by Mr. Poindexter, that the Commission confirm smard of contrast for the construction of Project DA-NR 1421 AML, Bridge over G & O Tracks (58th Street) Newport News From Intersection Route 60 (Firginia Avenue) - Intersection Route 168 (Jefferson Avenue), to the low hidder, on solicited hids received October 19th, Bowers Construction Company, Raleigh, N. G., at their bid of \$75,691.40, that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, \$6,600,00 for work by the railroad and \$6,380.00 for steel furnished by the State, making a total of approximately \$96,200.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carries.

Moved by Mr. Wysor, seconded by Mr. Wampler, that the Commission confirm the cancellation of contract on Project 5 556 Bl, Route 60, Bridge over Clinch River at Hackford, due to insbility to secure steel, Motion corried.

Moved by Mr. Wysor, seconded by Mr. Wempler, that the Consission confirm the cancellation of Class TO Contract for surface treatment in the Stammton District, due to the fact that priority rating sould not be obtained. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. DeMardit, seconded by Mr. Wampler, that the Commission confirm the cancellation of contract for Plant Mix Schedule \$14 in the Fredericksburg District, due to difficulties encountered in securing materials and labor. Motion carried. Moved by Mr. Rawis, seconded by Mr. Marrow, that as provided by Chapter 415, Act approved March 31, 1932, and Chapter 237, Act approved March 27, 1940, and upon recommendation of the Commissioner, the following sections of reads in Augusta County being no longer necessary for uses as a highway the same be abandoned upon opening of new sections in lieu thereof; Sections 3, 4 and 5 as shown on plat dated April 11, 1942, Project 1366 FS2, Houte 606, including the grade crossing on Section 4. That sections 1, 2 and 6 be added to the Secondary system, section 2 being a connection. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Rewis, seconded by Mr. Barrow, that as provided by Chapter 212, Scotion 1, Act approved March 19, 1926, and upon recommendation of the Countsioner, the following section of road in Palaski County being no longer necessary for uses as a highway the same be abandoned as a part of the Primary system and revert to the Secondary system: Section 1 as shown on plat dated July 16, 1942, Project 764 Cl, 754 Al, C2, Epute 100. As provided by Chapter 415, Act approved March 21, 1952, the following sections be abandoned: 2,3,4,5,6,7,8,9,10,11, 12,15,14 and 15 as shown on plat referred to. B2. Sections 1 and 2 also shown on the plat be abandoned as a part of the Privary system and revert to the Secondary system. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Mawls, seconded by Mr. Barrow, that as provided by Chapter 212, Section 1, Act approved March 19, 1926, and upon recommendation of the Commissioner, the following sections of Route 5 in Montgomery County being no longer necessary for uses as a highway the same be abandoned upon opening of new sections in lieu thereof: Sections 1,6 and 9 as shown on plat dated August 20, 1942, Project 568 DM2, That sections 2, 5, 7 and 8 shown on the plat be abandoned as a part of the Primary system and revert to the Secondary system. Motion carried.

Neved by Mr. Rawls, seconded by Mr. Berrow, that as provided by Chapter 212, Section 1, Act approved March 19, 1926, and upon recommendation of the Commissioner, the following section of Route 58 in Lee County being no longer necessary for uses as a highway the same be abandoned upon opening of new section in lieu thereof: Section 1 as shown on plat dated October 19, 1942, Project 122 AR2, B2. That sections 2 and 3 be abandoned as a part of the Primary System and revert to the Secondary System. As provided by Chapter 415, Act approved March 31, 1932, section /4 his added to the Secondary System as a connection. Notion carried.

Noved by Mr. Rawls, seconded by Mr. Barrow, that as provided by Chapter 237, Act approved March 27, 1940, and upon recommendation of the Commissioner, the following sestions of Route 614 in Nottoway County being no longer necessary for uses as a highway the same be abandoned upon opening of new sections in lieu thereof: Sections 1 and 2 shown on plat dated February 12, 1942, Project 1336 Kl,3, Hl,2. That sections 3 and 4 be added to the Secondary System in lieu of abandoned sections 1 and 2. Motion carried.

As provided by Chapter 415, Act approved March 31, 1932, section 3 shown on the plat referred to be added to the Secondary System as a connection. Motion carried,

Moved by Mr. Rawls, seconded by Mr. Barrow, that as previded by Chapter 212, Section 1, Act approved March 19, 1926, and upon recommendation of the Commissioner, the following section of Houte 234 in Prince William County being no longer necessary for uses as a highway the same be shandoned upon opening of new section in lieu thereof: Section 2 as shown on plat dated July 22, 1942, Project 1250 A, and Section 1 be shandoned as a part of the Primary System and revert to the Secondary System, As provided by Chapter 415, Act approved March 31, 1932, sections 3,4,5 and 6 be abandoned, sections 7 and 5 be dropped from the Secondary System, having been taken into the new location of Houte 234, and sections 9 and 10 be added to the System as connections, all as shown on plat referred to. Notion carried, Neved by Mr. Bands, seconded by Mr. Barrow, that as provided by Chapter 415, Act approved March 31, 1932, and Chapter 237, Act approved March 27, 1940, and upon recommendation of the Countamionar, the following sections of Secondary roads in Montgemery County being no longer necessary for uses as a higher the same be abandoned upon opening of new sections in lieu thereof: Sections 1,2,3,4,5,6,7,8,9, 10,11,12,13,14,15,16,17,18,19,20,21 and 22 as shown on plat dated September 4, 1942; Project 1273 A. Sections 24,25,26,27,28,29,30,31, 32,33,35,36,37,38,37,40,41,42 and 43 be added in lieu of abandoned sections and Section 23 be added as a connection, all as shown on plat referred to. Motion carried.

Moved by Kr. Rawle, seconded by Mr. Barrow that as previded by Chapter 212, Section 1, Act approved March 19, 1926, and upon recommendation of the Commissioner, the following sections of Primary highways in Warren County being no longer necessary for uses as a highway the same be abandoned upon opening of new sections in lieu thereof: Section 2B, 3B and 4(Boute 3) and Section 6 (Route 55) so shown on plat dated April 15, 1942, Project 1015 AD, CD3, R1,2. Sections 21,2C,3A, 3C(Route 3) and Section 5A(Route 55) he abandoned as a part of the Primary system and revert to the Secondary system. As provided by Chapter 415, Act approved March 31, 1942, and Chapter 237, Act approved March 27, 1940, Sections 7 and 8 be abandoned upon opening of new sections in lieu thereof, Section 1 be abandoned as a part of the Secondary system, having been taken into the new location of Route 3, and Sections 5B and 9 be added to the Secondary system as connections. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Rawls, seconded by Mr. Barrow, that as provided by Chapter 415, Act approved March 31, 1932, and upon recommendation of the Commissioner, the following section of Secondary Route 625 in Prince William County being no longer necessary for uses as a highway it be abandoned: Section 5 shown on plat dated Angust 10, 1942, Project 1217 AB1, and sections 2, 4, 6 and 7 be dropped from the Secondary System, having been taken into the new location of Route 15. Notion carried.

Moved by Mr. Rawls, seconded by General Anderson, as provided by Chapter 10, Act approved February 7, 1940, that since the residue parcel of Lot 1, Block 2 of Park View Subdivision, acquired from the James River Bridge System on Houte 239, Project 1288-Al, Warwick County, containing approximately 0,25 acre, will not be required for the uses of the State Highway System, as certified by the Chairman of the State Highway Commission, the sale of this parcel of land, lying cutside of the highway right of way, to H. F. Garyantes is approved; and the Chairman is hereby directed to execute, in the name of the Commonwealth, special warranty died making conveyance to said H. F. Garyantee in exchange for a consideration of \$4,00.00. Motion carried,

Moved by Mr. Rawls, seconded by Mr. Wampler, as provided by Chapter 10, Act approved February 7, 1940, that since it will not be necessary to retain that part of Lot \$14 of Cottage Green Subdivision acquired by the Commonwealth from Maude F. Clifford and Jack Clifford, her husband, by deed dated March 24, 1942, recorded in Deed Book 128, Page 122, Spotsylvania County, lying outside of the regular highway right of way acquired for Alternate Route 1 and Connection with Secondary Route 610, Project 1235 Cl, for the uses of the State Highway System, as certified by the Chairman of the State Highway Councission, the sale of this residue lot, containing approximately 0.14 acre, to A. L. Decatur is approved; spit the Chairman is hereby directed to execute, in the name of the Commonwealth, a special warranty deed making conveyance of this parcel of land to said A. L. Becatur in exchange for a consideration of \$300.00. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Rawls, seconded by Mr. Wampler, as provided by Chapter 10, Act approved February 7, 1940, that since the percels of land acquired by deeds from Charles E. Strang, B. L. Jenkins and Paulins P. Warner, lying between the centerline of old Route 5 and the West side of normal right of way 35 ft. west of the centerline of relocated Route 5; and the percel acquired from S. E. Frayeer lying between the Morth side of normal right of way, 35 ft. North of centerline of Route 146, and centerline of old road (known as Osborne Turnpike), Project 1221-E1,D, in Henrico County, are not necessary for the uses of the State Highway System, as certified by the Chairman of the State Highway Counission, the conveyance of these parcels, lying outside of the highway right of way, to Ethel Frayeer Archer is approved; and the Chairman is hereby directed to execute, in the name of the Commonwealth special warranty deed making conveyance of these parcels of land, and quit-claiming such right of way of the old roads adjacent thereto, to Ethel Frayeer Archer in exchange for right of way through her property. Notion carried.

Moved by Mr. Mysor, seconded by Mr. Poindexter, that permit No. 5272, Route 220, Henry County, issued October 4th, 1941, to H. L. Turner, East Salem, Virginia, be cancelled as requested. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Wysor, seconded by Mr. Poindexter, that permit Mo. 12252, Route 17, Horfolk County, issued February 17th,1942, to the Morfolk County Board of Supervisors, be cancelled as requested. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Wyeor, seconded by Mr. Poindexter, that permit No. 11332, Route 10, Chesterfield County, issued May 8th to W. H. Mason, 70% Broadway, Hopewell, Va., be cancelled as recommended by the Chief Engineer. Motion carried,

Moved by Mr. Wysor, seconded by Mr. Poindexter, that permit No.24180 S, Route 650, Giles County, issued October 14th, 1942, to the Appalachian Electric Power Company, Electricial, West Va., be cancelled as requested. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Rawle, seconded by Mr. DeBardit, that the Commission ellocate to the City of Martineville the \$500,000 per mile construction fund for the year 1942-43, to be applied to the reconstruction of the B. and W. Railway Underpass on Route 108 in the City. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Rawle, seconded by Mr. DeHardit, that the Commission allegate to the Town of Morton the \$500.00 per mile construction fund for the year 1942-1943 for expenditure on Boute 23 in the Town. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Ramls, seconded by Mr. DeHardit, that the Commission allocate the \$500.00 per mile construction fund to the City of Bristel for 1942-1943 to be expended on Route 11 to continue the work for which the 1941-1942 money was allocated. Notion carried.

Moved by Mr. Rawle, seconded by Mr. DeHardit, that inasmuch as Primary Route 152 in Halifax County, a distance of 0.32 mile, was deleted from the system and transferred to the Secondary System, that 0.854 mile of this Route in South Boston, from Wilburn Avenue, Edwards Street to the Airport be dropped as approved State Highway mileage in the City of South Boston. Motion carried,

Moved by Mr. Rawle, seconded by Mr. DeHardit, that inasmuch as Primary Route 297 in Campbell County, a distance of 0.8 mile, was deleted from the system and transferred to the Secondary System, that 0.096 mile of this Route in Lynchburg, from U. S. Route 501 to State Route 291 (Forest Road to W.C.L.Lynchburg) be dropped as approved State Highway mileage in the City of Lynchburg. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Rawle, seconded by Mr. Wysor, that the following exchange of mileage be made: that U. S. Route 250 in Albemarle County be put on the newly improved section of Route 240, and that No. 240 be placed on the section now numbered 250 from Machana River to Croset, and extend Route 230 south from Croset to present Route 240. Motion carried.

Moved by General Anderson, seconded by Mr. Wysor, that the request of the Prince Edward County Board of Supervisors to add 14 miles of secondary highways, Houtes 665 and 671, being a connecting link between Boutes 15 and 47, be not granted. Motion carried.

Two very timely and thoughtful editorials that appeared in the Times Dispatch September 22nd and 27th respectively, with reference to "Reads to the Future" and "The Shirley Highmay", were brought to the attention of the Commission. The Chairman previously had expressed the appreciation of the Department in a letter to the Editor of the Times Dispatch.

Mr. Mullen advised the Commission briefly as to the present construction and maintenance program and the outlook for the winter months.

Moved by Mr. Renks, seconded by Mr. Typop, that the Dominston approve the permits issued from September 15th to Horomber 15th inclusive, as resorted in the Auditing Division. Notion carried.

Moved by Mr. Mysor, seconded by Mr. Newls, that the former location of Moute S in Giles County, from a peint near Bluff City, running on the south side of New Miver through Hayrows and across New River, be retained as a part of the Primary system of highways and be given numbers which will best fit in with the numbered system of the State. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Mysor, seconded by Mr. DeHagdit, that Route ldl, extension through Richmond, be designated to run over the Boulevard, across the Boulevard Bridge, thanse along the Belt Boulevard to the new south comporate limits of Richmond; and from the south comporate limits of Richmond at the Atlantic Coast Line-Belt Boulevard to Route 1, giving to Richmond a total set mileage, excluding the tell bridge, of 2,962 to be taken over as of January 1, 1943, Motion carried,

On Saturday norming, November 14th, the Chemission reasonabled at 8:00 f.K. and continued the inspection trip until 1:00 P.N. By unminous vote the meeting adjourned, subject to the call of the Consissioner.
