Neeting of State Highway Commission of Virginia Richmond, Virginia November 16, 1961

The State Highway Commission of Virginia met at the Central Highway Office, Richmond, Virginia, at 9:00 A.M., EST, on November 16, 1961. The Chairman, R. H. Harris, presided.

Present: Chairman H. H. Harris, Measts. E. P. Barrow, W. M. Chinn, Jr., S. S. Flythe, Burgess E. Helson, S. W. Rawls, W. M. Schater, Jr., and Tucker C. Watkins, Jr. Mr. G. Wallace Carper was absent due to illness.

On motion of Mr. Rawls, seconded by Mr. Sciater, the minutes of the meeting of October 26, 1961 were approved.

Motion was made by Mr. Rawle, seconded by Mr. Sciater, that parmits issued from October 26, 1961 to November 15, 1961, inclusive, as shown in records of the Department, be approved. Motion carried.

On working of Mr. Rawls, seconded by Mr. Schater, cancellation of permits from October 26, 1961 to Movember 15, 1961, inclusive, as shown in records of the Department, was approved.

Notion was made by Mr. Hawle, seconded by Mr. Harrow, that the Commission approve the Annual Report for the year ended June 30, 1961. Motion carried.

The Commission discussed the proposal of Governor-elect Harrison for an increase in Industrial Access Funds and it was the general opinion of the members that some provision for an increase in these funds should be made.

Delegate Tom Frost appeared before the Commission to urge the completion of construction of Route 17 between Opel and Sealeton before Hovember 1, 1962, if possible.

WHERAS, one section of the old road is no longer secessery as a public road, the new road serving the same citizens as the old; and one section of the old road is to be transferred to the Secondary System of Highways;

HOW, TREESFORS, SE IT RESOLVED, that pursuant to Section 33-76.5 of the Code of Virginia of 1950, as amended, 0.80 wile of the old road, shown in blue and designated as Section 2 on the plat dated July 11, 1961, Project 7058-097-104, be abandoned as a part of the State Highway System;

SE IT FURTHER RESCLUED, that pursuant to Section 33-27 of the Code of Virginia of 1950, as amended, 0.75 mile of the old toad, shown in red and designated as Section 1 on the plat and project referred to hereinshove, be transferred from the Primary System to the Secondary System of Highways. Moved by Mr. Chinn, seconded by Mr. Rawls, that WHERAS, interstate route number "295" has beretofore been officially adopted for the designation of the proposed Richmond Sami-Circumferential Highway, and whereas the route number assignment is confusing with present State Route 295 by the duplicated route numbers;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that existing State Route 295, beginning at the intersection of Noute 28 southwest of Manages to the intersection of Boutes 29 and 211 west of Buckland, be renumbered to carry new State Route 215, effective this date. Notion carried.

A delegation of approximately seventy-five citizens from King George, Caroline and Hanover Counties, handed by Senator Thomas H. Blanton, presented to the Countiesion a plan for improvement of Route 301 from the Potomac River to Richmond.

On notion of Mr. Selater, seconded by Mr. Sarrow, the Commission voted to dispense with the December meeting.

The meeting adjourned at 11:30 A.M.
