Minutes of the meeting of the State Highway Commission held in Washington, D. C., December 15th, 1920.

The State Highery Commission, all members in attendance, namely; while H. Massie, Chairman, Henry P. Beek, Secretary, James A. Muzdy, Jr., Horses Hardawsy, and R. W. Davie, met in Washington on December 13th, to attend the annual meeting of the American Association of State Rightey Officials which was held at the Washington Notel December 13th to 16th, inclusive.

On Monday afternoon, Becamber 13th, the State
Righmy Commission wet at the Haleigh Rotal to hear a delegation
from the City of Alexandria and a committee representing the
Board of Supervisors of Reinfex County in reference to the anticipation of State Righmy funds by the county of Fairfex and
as to the method of repaying the money so advanced by the
County.

After a lengthy discussion by all parties interested in the matter, the Chairman of the Highway Commission
amounted that the contract as drawn and as submitted to the
Fairfax Supervisors would not be altered and that the agreement
must be accepted by the authorities if they wanted to take adventage of the law authorizing the anticipation of State read
allocations.

On motion of Mr. Hardway the Highway Commissioner

was enthorized to outer into a contract with the United States
Porestry Rayeou for the construction of five and one built miles
of State Righmay Route Mo.14 in the season of 1922 to an expent
not to exceed 198,000.

On notion of kr. Mardamy the following men were appointed members of the State Traffic Police Force:

R. R. MoThirt, Laintenance Forecas. I., V. Brishell, Forecas. W. J. Spain, Forecas. John R. Snecden, Forecas.

Andrew Hortham, Foremen.

On notion of Mr. Kundy the County of Southempton was allowed to advance \$227,200 for the construction of 4.82 miles of State Highway No.5 between Schrell and the Sussex County Line, and the Chairman and the Secretary of the State Highway Commission were sufficient and empowered to enter into a contract on behalf and in the name of the State Highway Commission with the Board of Emporations of Southempton County.

on motion of Mr. Davis the minutes of the meeting of November 4th and 5th were approved after being read, and the Chairman authorized to sign the same.

On action of Mr. Lumdy the Commission edjourned, in order to attend the meetings of the American association of State Mighway Officials.
