

Minutes of the meeting of the State Highway
Commission held in Washington, D. C., December
13th, 1920.

The State Highway Commission, all members in attendance, namely; Wade H. Masnie, Chairman, Henry P. Neek, Secretary, James A. Mundy, Jr., Horace Hardaway, and F. W. Davis, met in Washington on December 13th, to attend the annual meeting of the American Association of State Highway Officials which was held at the Washington Hotel December 13th to 16th, inclusive.

On Monday afternoon, December 13th, the State Highway Commission met at the Raleigh Hotel to hear a delegation from the City of Alexandria and a committee representing the Board of Supervisors of Fairfax County in reference to the anticipation of State Highway funds by the county of Fairfax and as to the method of repaying the money so advanced by the County.

After a lengthy discussion by all parties interested in the matter, the Chairman of the Highway Commission announced that the contract as drawn and as submitted to the Fairfax Supervisors would not be altered and that the agreement must be accepted by the authorities if they wanted to take advantage of the law authorizing the anticipation of State road allocations.

On motion of Mr. Hardaway the Highway Commissioner

was authorized to enter into a contract with the United States Forestry Bureau for the construction of five and one half miles of State Highway Route No.14 in the season of 1932 to an amount not to exceed \$95,000.

On motion of Mr. Hardway the following men were appointed members of the State Traffic Police Force:

On motion of Mr. Kandy the County of Southampton was allowed to advance \$327,200 for the construction of 4.83 miles of State Highway No.5 between Sebrell and the Sussex County Line, and the Chairman and the Secretary of the State Highway Commission were authorized and empowered to enter into a contract on behalf and in the name of the State Highway Commission with the Board of Supervisors of Southampton County.

On motion of Mr. Davis the minutes of the meeting of November 4th and 5th were approved after being read, and the Chairman authorized to sign the same.

On motion of Mr. Kandy the Commission adjourned, in order to attend the meetings of the American Association of State Highway Officials.
