## MEETING OF STATE HIGHWAY AND TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION PULASKI, and LEXINGTON, VIRGINIA

**DECEMBER 9, 10, 1924** 

took libert No. 25-P 19th Workley Co. MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE STATE HERWAY COMMISSION, HELD AT PULNSKY AND LEXINOTON, VIRCIBIA, ON DECRIBER 9th and 10th, 1924.

On the norming of December 9th, the State Highway Commission, consisting of Mesors. H. G. Shirley, Chairman, Wade H. Massic, Secretary, A. J. Huff, and I. Walks Truxtum, not at Fulneki, Virginia, and gave a public houring at the Court House on the allocation of funds and the distribution of mileage under the 24% Clauses of the Law for the Bristol and Salam Districts.

After this hearing they proceeded by automobile to Resnoke where the night was spent and on the morning of the 10th continued to Laxington, where they were joined by Commissioner Sproul, and gave a public hearing at the Court House on the allocation of funds and the distribution of mileage under the 21% Clauses of the Law for the Stauston and Lynchburg Districts.

After the morning basing the Commission held a regular business meeting and transported the following business:

Moved by Mr. Truxtum, seconded by Mr. Sproul, that the contrast for the construction of the bridge over Buffalo Greek, Route 33, project 65%, be swarded to the low bidder, Remarke Iron and Bridge Works, Rounder, Virginia, &t their hid of \$18,048.28, and that 10% additional be set unide to cover the cost of contingencies and engineering, making a total of \$19,853.10 chargonable to this Project, subject to the approval of the plane by the Bureau of Public Bonds. Notion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Sproul, that the contract for the construction of 3.025 Miles of gravel road, Route 38, Project 126, Mess ||hole ||**them ||No. 93-**||P ||with Waddily CX. Rock-Happahannock Academy, be awarded to the low hidder, C. J. Luck and Sons, Richmond, Virginia, at their bid of \$55,743.10; and that 10% additional be set acide to cover the cost of contingencies and engineering, making a total of \$64,617.41 chargeable against the 1924 allocation of \$50,000.00, the excess emount of approximately \$14,600.00 to be charged against the 1925 allocations to the Fredericksburg District. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Buff, seconded by Mr. 3proal, that the contract for the construction of .481 miles of 16' surface treated musadan road between .25 miles east of Pounding .311 to .21 miles west of Pounding Mill, including bridge over Olinoh River, Route 11, Project 208C, be smarded to the low bidder V. E. Cornett and Company, Appalachia, Virginia, at their bid of 454,962.80, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of contingencies and engineering, making a total of \$60,459.08 chargeable against the 1925 allocation of \$75,000.00. Motion corried.

Moved by Mr. Truxtum, seconded by Mr. Half, that the contract for the construction of a bridge over Nottowny River, Roste 121, Project 246, be awarded to the lew bidder, Robert W. Curtis, Lynchburg, Va, on his alternate bid using steel stringers, of \$64,711.00 and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of contingencies and engineering, saking a total of \$71,182.10 charges his against the 1924 allocation of \$100,000.00. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Huff, that the contrast for the construction of 2.274 miles 18' construct read, route 10, Project 3660, Ritchiez Storm, West, Se awarded to the low bidder, Weinbrum and Corporter, 1015 North 6th St. Richmond, Va. at their bid of \$60,089.80 and that 10% additional be not uside to cover the cost of contingencies and engineering and \$750.00 for detour,

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making a total of \$66,848.78 chargeable against the 1924 allocation of \$75,000.00. Motion carried.

Loved by Mr. Sprund, accorded by Mr. Marsis, that the contract for the construction of 6.223 miles of grading and drainage, House 14, Project 375, 14 miles each of Crows-Fest Virginia Line, be exarded to the low bidder, M. P. Baker, Hickmond, Virginia, at his bid of \$127,629.67 and that 10% additional be set uside to cover the cost of contingencies and engineering, and \$517.00 for detours, making a total of \$140.909.63 charges be against the 1924 allocation of \$100,000.00 and the 1925 allocation of \$75,000.00. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Truxtum, seconded by Mr. Huff, that the State Highway Commission pay the smount of \$36.00 damage done Mr. Ame Trussler's car by reason of their truck driver Mr. Sidney Wood, running into his car beauting this expount of damage, Mr. Wood having been agreeted for reaklage driving and fixed. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massio, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that an extension of time of fifteen days be granted Gammany and Radgins, Contractors on Project 328, Route 394, Phoebus-Buckros Beach, due to excessive rains, as per recommendation of Chief Engineer Mullen. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that an extension of time be granted Mr. M. T. Mearthur, Johnson City, Tenn, Contractor on Project 327, Route 113, Moorefield-Hamlin, to October Sth. 1924, as per resonmendation of Chief Engineer Bullen. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Maggie, esconded by Mr. Huff, that the following permits be granted under the rules and regulations of the Commission:
The Board of Supervisors of Arlington County, to lay a 5° concrete side walk in the Town of Cherrydale.

- To Mr. E. A. Smith, Altevista, Virginia, to lay water and sever swins in Town of Altevista, Route 14,
- To Er. J. S. Riddle, Kentenia, Tentucky, to put a 24" pipe across State Highsay No. 115 at Jouth and of Appalachia on east side of LANGA Tracks.
- To Noticemy Light and Power Company to extend an electric line on Route 323 southwest of Biackstone for a distance of about 2 miles.

## Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the application of the Board of Separvisors of Sland County to advance money under the Robertson Act for the construction of a road from Elend Court House via Bastain, Micksville, South Gap and Rocky Gap to the Fest Virginia Line at Abshire's Dap on the top of East River Education, be not accepted as only the portion of the road from Eland Court House to Bastain is in the State Righmay System and therefore the Commission cannot make any expenditures on other than the portion included in the System. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Sproul, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the tell house at the south end of the Fulmouth Bridge be put up at public austion and sold for a price not less than \$50.00. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Sproul, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the sward of the jury of \$550.00 given Mr. Ritchie for right of way through his property on Route 39 just west of Churchville, be accepted. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Truxtum, that the Chairman be authorized to accept under the Robertson Act \$400,000.00 for the construction

Both Mars No. 36-T attl Binkley Co. of a bridge over the Rappelsannouk River at Tappelsannock, \$200,000.00 of this amount to be accepted previous to July 1st, 1925, and the other \$200,000.00 after that date. Motion carried.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
