

Minutes of the Meeting of the State Highway
Commission of Virginia, Held in
Richmond, December 5, 1933.

On the morning of December 5th, 1933, The State Highway Commission, consisting of Messrs. H. G. Shirley, Wade H. Massie, Secretary, H. G. Gilmer, W. H. East, and S. W. Rawls, met in their office, state offices building, Richmond.

The meeting was called to order by the Commissioners.

Moved by Mr. East, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the minutes of the meeting of October 19th be approved. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. East, that the Commission confirm award of contract for the construction of Project HRS 1056, Route 460, Airlines Turnpike in City of Portsmouth, to the low bidder, R. T. Graham Company, Inc., Norfolk, Va., at their bid of \$40,548.00, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$45,000.00 chargeable to this project, on the basis of Book Asphalt, using regular cement. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. East, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that the Commission confirm award of contract for the construction of Project HRS 797 HF, Route 114, Trinity-Intersection of Route 11, to the low bidder, Sam E. Finley, and G. T. Franklin, Roanoke, Va., at their bid of \$88,661.67, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, \$4,876.50 for work outside slope stakes; \$800.00 for detours; \$1,160.50 for guard rail, and \$10,630.64 for surface treatment, making a total of approximately \$115,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that the Commission confirm award of contract for the construction of Project HRS 628 A2, Route 168, 6.34 Mi. N. NCL Newport News-9.75 Mi. N. NCL Newport News, to the low bidder, Virginia Engineering Company, Newport News, Va., at their bid of \$64,026.64, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work; \$1,871.41 for work outside slope stakes; \$812.74 for soil rights, and \$6,874.50 for surface treatment, making a total of approximately \$74,700.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the Commission confirm award of contract for the construction of Project 751 A1, Route 340, 1.17 Mi. S. SCL of Front Royal-2.4 Mi. S. SCL Front Royal, to the low bidder, Monongah Construction Co., Fairmont, West Va., at their bid of \$44,951.82, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work; \$2,472.51 for work outside slope stakes; \$1,397.40 for guard rail, and \$2,264.32 for surface treatment, making a total of approximately \$56,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. East, that the Commission confirm award of contract for the construction of Project MME 785 ACB1, Route 26, 2 Mi. N. Phoenix-6.94 Mi. N. Phoenix, to the low bidder, W. W. Tuck and Son and F. M. Arthur, Virgilina, Va., at their bid of \$44,252.37, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work; \$3,453.78 for work outside slope stakes; \$384.76 for soil rights; \$800.00 for detours, and \$3,534.30 for surface treatment, making a total of approximately \$56,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. East, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that the Commission confirm award of contract for the construction of Project 1014 ABL2, Route 259, 2.4 Mi. S. West Virginia Line-West Virginia Line, to the low bidder, Pocahontas Construction Co., Cass, West Va., at their bid of \$81,788.30, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work; \$1,745.00 for work outside slope stakes; \$435.98 for soil rights, and \$3,328.68 for surface treatment, making a total of approximately \$92,000.00 chargeable to this project, and that \$12,000.00 required to bring the allocation to the amount necessary be transferred from some other work. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that the Commission confirm award of contract for the construction of Project 1013D, Route 48, Unionville-6.8 Mi. S. of Unionville, to the low bidder, D. M. Houser, Stony Creek, Va., provided G. P. Gray, Richmond, Va., who is associated with Mr. Houser, signs the contract jointly with D. M. Houser, at his bid of \$66,722.90, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work; \$3,614.76 for work outside slope stakes; \$1,290.12 for soil rights, and \$11,338.15 for surface treatment, making a total of approximately \$80,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that the Commission confirm award of contract for the construction of Project MME 778 CBL, Route 16, 0.598 Mi. S. Int. Route 16-0.34 Mi. S. Intersection Route 16, to the low bidder, Boxley Bros. Co. Inc., Orange, Va., at their bid of \$41,687.30, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work; \$2,297.79 for work outside slope stakes; \$354.50 for guard rail, and \$677.40 for surface treatment, making a total of approximately \$49,000.00 chargeable to this project; and that the \$14,000.00 necessary to bring the allocation to the amount required be transferred from Route 5, Project 782, Chester Gap-South. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. East, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the Commission confirm award of contract for the construction of Project MME 751 JBL3,4, Route 340, 1.00 Mi. N. Luray-1.86 Mi. N. Luray, to the low bidder, Beaton Construction Co. Inc., South Beaton, Va., at their bid of \$87,513.86, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work; \$3,153.20 for work outside slope stakes; \$56.34 for soil rights, and \$570.90 for surface treatment, making a total of approximately \$92,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that the Commission confirm award of contract for the construction of Project EKH 372 BRWZ2, Route 1, 5.85 Mi. S. Four Mile Fork-Four Mile Fork, to the low bidder, Rooley Bros. Co. Inc., Orange, Va., at their bid of \$110,920.81, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work; \$6,100.41 for work outside slope stakes, and \$1,364.50 for guard rail, making a total of approximately \$128,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Mast, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that the Commission confirm award of contract for the construction of Project EKH 1027A, Route 460, 0.18 Mi. N. Fourth Street, N.W.-Tinker Creek, in Roanoke, to the low bidder, W. W. Braper and Co., Roanoke, Va., at their bid of \$53,282.65, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$59,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Massie, that action of the Commission on Project EKH 1047A, Route 501, NCL South Boston-0.89 Mi. S. of NCL South Boston, of November 18th, rejecting all bids, be rescinded and the contract to the amount of \$15,809.00 be awarded to the low bidder, provided he will accept the same. Motion carried.

Motion carried.

WCL Big Stone Gap-WCL Big Stone Gap, to the low bidder, Wise Construction Corp., Big Stone Gap, Va., at their bid of \$85,322.06, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work; \$1,362.50 for guard rail, and \$1,653.60 for surface treatment, making a total of approximately \$82,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Motion carried.

Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the Commission confirm award of contract for the construction of Project HHH 111 IB2, Route 181, 0.18 Mi. E. Little Reed Island Creek-19 Mi. W. Crowder, Ivanhoe, Va., at their bid of \$15,840.15, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work; \$150.00 for work outside slope stakes; \$15.88 for soil rights; \$350.15 for guard rail, and \$689.75 for surface treatment, making a total of approximately \$19,000.00 chargeable to this project, and that \$15,000.00 be transferred from Route 11, HHH 721, Buchanan-North and South to this project. Motion carried.

Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that the Commission confirm award of contract for the construction of Project HHH 797G, Route 18, 5.15 Mi. S. HCL Pinecastle-Trinity, to the low bidders, G. T. Franklin and Son E. Finley, Bassett and Roanoke, Va., at their bid of \$4,571.84, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work; \$100.00 for work outside slope stakes, and \$333.81 for surface treatment, making a total of approximately \$6,000.00 chargeable to this project, the contract time on this project to start at the completion of Project 797 EP. Motion carried.

Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. East, that the Commission reject all bids on Project HHH 1080, Route 644, Gosportella Bridge-Bridge over Eastern Branch of Elizabeth River in Norfolk - due to the improper amount of wet excavation shown in the proposal, and readvertise the project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the Commission having reconsidered the bids on Project MRR 285 WZ, Route 50, Seven Pines- .95 Mi. E. of Richmond, at the request of the Bureau of Public Roads, who would not approve of the contract going to the Atlantic Bituminous Co., they confirm their decision to award contract to G. P. Clay and L. K. Williams, Inc., Richmond, Va., on bituminous material, at their bid of \$91,041.94, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, and \$1,684.60 for work outside slope stakes, making a total of approximately \$103,000.00 chargeable to this project. The Commission to widen out the roadthrough Sandston and the property holders to provide sidewalks. Motion carried.

Motion carried.

Appalachian Electric Power Co., Roanoke, Va., to install one service crossover on Route 12 about 3/4 mile north of Trinity, in Botetourt County.

Appalachian Electric Power Co., Roanoke, Va., to install 8 poles on Route 118 from end of present line to Route 117, making one crossover, Roanoke County.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that the Chairman be authorized to transfer N.R.A. allocations as recommended by the Chief Engineer on December 5th, as follows -

Bristol District

Transfer from Lynchburg District, allocation Amherst-West, \$50,000.00 to Route 58, Rose Hill-West, making total allocation of \$95,000.00, which will provide for the completion of a section of this road which was partially worked over with R.F.C. funds.

Transfer from Amherst-West, \$25,000.00 to Route 25, Big Stone Gap-Irondale
and

Transfer from Haysi-Fremont, \$50,000.00 to Big Stone Gap-Irondale, making total allocation of \$65,000.00 which will be sufficient to build this stretch of road and eliminate from the Federal Aid System the road by East Stone Gap on which there are three unsatisfactory bridges.

Transfer Haysi-Fremont, which is not on Federal System, to the Secondary System, using \$50,000.00 of the \$50,000.00 allocated for Wise County Secondary Roads.

In the Secondary System, eliminate Wise Secondary Roads, and substitute County Secondary Road, \$20,000.00

Transfer \$15,000.00 from Van Sant-Haysi to Haysi-Fremont. This will reallocate the money to make continuous the work from Van Sant, Haysi, to Fremont.

From the Municipal allocations in the Staunton District, transfer \$15,000.00 from Mount Sidney to Big Stone Gap, for approaches to Powell River Bridge on Route 58.

Salem District

Transfer from Glade Hill-Pittsylvania County Line \$20,000.00 to Emis Overhead
and
Transfer from Amherst-West, \$40,000.00 to Emis Overhead, making total
allocation of \$60,000.00

Transfer from Amherst-West, \$18,000.00 to Route 311, Roanoke-South,
Franklin Road Route.

Transfer from Amherst-West, \$50,000.00 to Route 29, Independence-North.
This is necessary to take care of the contract for which bids have just
been received.

From the Municipal allocations in the Staunton District, transfer from
Mount Sidney \$10,000.00 to Martinsville for Starling Street Overhead,
Route 311.

Lynchburg District

Repairs to Banister River Bridge and Approaches, making this a 12 ton bridge
and 24 foot roadway, are estimated to cost \$15,000.00. Transfer \$25,000.00
to Route 16, Keysville-South.

Culpeper District

Transfer from Richmond District allocation of \$100,000.00, Bellwood Overhead
and \$50,000.00 Goodes Ferry Bridge, to Route 15, Warrenton-North.

Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that the 2.65 miles
of road to be added under the 2^{1/2}% Clause for the current year in the
Richmond District, be from "Tiggarana, Route 60, (old Route 15) to a point
at or near Powhatan Courthouse on Route 60, (old Route 13)." Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that the request of
the citizens of Powhatan County to make certain changes in the secondary
system in regard to the Finches Mill Road, be postponed by the Commission
until the law suits now pending have been decided, at which time the matter
will be considered. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the 0.8 mile of
road on Route 64, Project 761A, in Lee County, "beginning at L & N on Route
64, Unkepass, one mile east of intersection of Route 65 to Route 64, 0.1 miles
east of intersection of Route 65", be abandoned as a state route, and be
added to Lee County Secondary System on Route 640. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Rawls, that the following
sections of road on Route 1 in Stafford County be abandoned, and that 0.75
mile beginning at the Prince William County Line and intersection of Route 1
near County Route 611 be added to the secondary system.

From a point approximately 0.8 mile north of Cranes Corner on Route 1, to a point 0.7 Mi. N. of Cranes Corner on Route 1.

From a point on Route 1, 2.82 Mi. S. of intersection of Route 1 and Route 212, to a point on Route 1, 2.92 Mi. S. of intersection of Route 1 and Route 212.

From a point on Route 1, 2.8 Mi. S. of intersection of Route 1 and Route 212, to a point on Route 1, 2.88 Mi. S. of intersection of Route 1 and Route 212.

From a point on Route 1, 2.8 Mi. S. of intersection of Route 1 and Route 212, to a point on Route 1, 2.96 Mi. S. of the intersection of Route 1 and Route 212.

From a point on Route 1, 0.27 Mi. E. of Int. of Route 1 and Route 212, to a point on Route 1, 0.54 Mi. N. of Int. of Route 1 and Route 212.

From a point on Route 1, 1.6 Mi. N. of Aquia Creek to a point on Route 1, 1.65 Mi. N. of Aquia Creek.

From a point on Route 1, 1.66 Mi. N. of Aquia Creek, to a point on Route 1, 1.7 Mi. N. of Aquia Creek.

Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. East, seconded by Mr. Bowles, that the following sections of Route 7 in Clarke County be abandoned as a part of the primary and secondary highways.

Beginning at a point 2.05 Mi. W. of WUL of Berryville and running .22 Mi. to a point 2.27 Mi. W. of WUL of Berryville, length 0.22 miles.

Beginning at a point on Route 7, 1.6 Mi. W. of WCL of Berryville and running 0.27 Mi. W. to a point 1.37 Mi. W. of WCL of Berryville, length 0.37 miles.

Beginning at a point on Route 7, 3.54 Mi. W. of WUL of Berryville and running 0.27 Mi. W. of a point 3.81 Mi. W. of WUL of Berryville, .27 miles.

Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that the section of Route 17 in Spotsylvania County, "from intersection of State Route 2-Northwest, 1.10 miles", be abandoned as a section of the state highway system, due to relocation. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that the section of Route 29 in Culpeper County, "from 3.529 Mi. W. of W.C.L. of Culpeper, to 4.507 Mi. W. of W.C.L. of Culpeper, length 1.0 mile", be abandoned, due to relocation. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Rawls, seconded by Mr. East, that the section of road cut off by the construction of Project 707A, Route 205, in Westmoreland County, 0.8 mile in length, beginning at a point 0.26 mile west of the intersection of Routes 205 and C-630, extending by Maple Grove P.O. and intersecting Route 205, 0.8 mile west of Maple Grove P.O., be abandoned as a part of the primary highway system and added to the secondary system, and that the following sections be completely abandoned -

Section of road, 0.15 mile in length, beginning at Int. of State Route 205 and County Route 629 and extending east.

Section of road 1 mile in length, beginning at a point 0.91 miles E. of Int. of Route 205 and County Route 630, and going east.

Section of road 0.58 mile in length, beginning at a point 1.86 Mi. E. of Int. of Route 205 and County Route 630, and again intersecting Route 205 at Potomac Beach.

Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. East, seconded by Mr. Rawls, that the following section of Route 11 in Augusta County be abandoned as a part of the primary system, due to relocation, and be added to the secondary system -

Beginning at a point on old Route 11, 0.07 Mi. S. of Int. of C-630 and Route 11 and running to a point on Route 11 south, a distance of .21 miles.

That the following sections of Route 11 in Augusta County be completely abandoned, due to relocation,

Beginning at a point on Route 11, 0.38 Mi. S. of Rockingham County-Augusta County Line and running S. 0.22 Mi. to Int. of Route 11 at a point 0.16 Mi. N. of Int. of Route 11 and County Road 630, a distance of .22 miles.

Beginning at a point 0.25 Mi. S. of Augusta-Rockingham County Line and running S. to the Int. of old Route 11 and new Route 11, 0.4 Mi. N. of Int. of Route 11 and County Road 630, a distance of .17 miles.

Beginning at a point on Route 11, 0.39 Mi. E. of Int. of Route 266 and Route 11 and running S. and on the west of Route 11 a distance of 0.96 Mi. to a point on Route 11 at the Int. of County Road 770 and Route 11, a distance of 0.96 Mi.

Beginning at a point on Route 11 at the Int. of C-680 and Route 11 and running S. on old Route 11, a distance of 0.07 miles.

Beginning at a point on Route 11, 0.2 Mi. S. of Int. of Route C-770 and Route 11 and running south and on the west side of Route 11, a distance of 0.15 Mi. and intersecting Route 11, a distance of 0.13 mile.

Beginning at a point on Route 11, 1.04 Mi. S. of the Int. of Route C-612 and Route 11 and running south and on the west side of Route 11 a distance of 0.68 mile, to a point on Route 11, 1.14 Mi. N. of Int. of C-793 and Route 11, a distance of 0.68 mile.

Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Rawles, that the sick leave of Mr. J. E. Vines, be extended eleven days with pay.

Motion carried.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned subject to the call of the Commissioner.
