Meeting of State Highway Commission of Virginia Richmond, Virginia December 20, 1962

The State Highway Commission of Virginia met at the Central Highway Office in Richmond, Virginia at 10:00 A.M. on December 20, 1962. The Chairman, H. H. Harris, presided.

Moved by Mr. Sclater, Seconded by Mr. Landrith, that WHEREAS, in 1962 the General Assembly, realising the increased industrial development in Virginia, smended and re-enacted Section 33-136.1 to increase the Industrial Access fund from \$1,000,000, to \$1,500,000; and

WHEREAS, the requests for the use of Industrial Access funds, for the purpose of constructing new or improving existing roads to new or expending manufacturing or industrial establishments, have continued to increase to the point where all of the increased funds are being obligated before the end of the fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, from time to time requests are received for the construction of access roads to facilities other than those normally associated with industrial sites on which manufacturing or processing establishments have been or are being established.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that it is the sense of the Commission that Industrial Access funds not be used for the construction of access roads to hospitals, libraries, armories, and other public or semipublic facilities.

The Commission hereby directs that a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the Board of Supervisors of each county, the Chambers of Commerce, and the State Division of Industrial Development and Planning. Motion carried.

HE, IT RESCIVED, that the construction of this project be approved in accordance with the general plan as proposed and presented by the Engineering Division of the Department of Highways. This proposed improvement will provide a parallel lane to the existing facility and expand this route to a four-lane divided highway. Hotion Carried.

MHESEAS, the economic effects of the proposed relocation have been examined and given proper consideration, and this evidence, along with all other, has been carefully reviewed, now therefore,

ME IT RESOLVED, that the construction of this project be approved in accordance withthe general plan as revised and proposed by the Engineering Division of the Department of Highways.

This proposed location crosses Route 58 east of South Hill and near Secondary Route 643, crosses Route 1 north of South Hill near Secondary Route 754, then parellels Route 1 on the west to near the Town of Alberta. MOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that quarterly payments at the base rate of \$300 per mile annually be made to the Town of Altavista on additional streams totaling 0.59 mile that have been broughtup to standards required by this section of the Code, effective beginning January 1, 1963, with thefirst quarterly payment due after March 31, 1963.
