WHEREAS, in connection with Route 122, State Highway
Project 0122-009-101,RW-202, the Commonwealth acquired certain land from
S. B. Creasy by instrument dated October 6, 1967, recorded in Deed Book 342,
Page 431, in the Office of the Clerk of the Circuit Court of Bedford County; and

WHEREAS, the Commonwealth is also the apparent owner of Old Route 122 in Bedford County; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 33.1-148 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, the Commonwealth Transportation Board at its meeting held January 23, 1969, abandoned a section of old Route 122; and

WHEREAS, the Commonwealth Transportation Commissioner has certified in writing that a portion of the lands containing 0.43 acre, more or less, lying east of and adjacent to the east right of way line of Route 122, from a point approximately 55 feet opposite approximate Station 196+25 (Route 122 centerline) to a point approximately 55 feet opposite approximate Station 201+42 (Route 122 centerline) does not constitute a section of the public road and is deemed no longer necessary for the uses of the State Highway System; and

WHEREAS, the adjacent landowners have requested that the surplus lands be conveyed.

WHEREAS, on October 14, 1998, the Commonwealth Transportation Board approved an allocation of \$151,000 to provide access to Fighting Creek Park in Powhatan County, Project 0687-072-162,N501, subject to certain contingencies; and

WHEREAS, Powhatan County has revised its park development plans and the required access road project's estimated cost has increased significantly.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that \$171,250 (\$99,000 unmatched and \$72,250 matched) from the 1999-2000 Fiscal Year Recreational Access Fund be allocated to supplement the 1998-99 Fiscal Year Allocation of \$151,000 to construct the access road to serve park facilities within Fighting Creek Park, Project 0687-072-162,N50I, contingent upon:

- all necessary right of way, environmental assessments, and utility adjustments being provided at no cost to the Recreational Access Fund;
- the execution of an appropriate contractual agreement between the County of Powhatan (COUNTY) and the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT), to provide for the design, administration, construction, project inspection and maintenance of this project;
- the provision of the required \$72,250 in matching funds by the County;
- the payment of all ineligible project costs and all eligible project costs in excess of \$322,250 from sources other than the Recreational Access Fund.

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Item 12:

Moved by Mr. Humphreys, seconded by Mr. Martin, that

WHEREAS, the Virginia Department of Transportation has the following projects in various stages of development in the City of Norfolk that will require right of way from the Norfolk Naval Station:

- Railroad grade separation on Hampton Boulevard at Greenbrier Avenue, Project Number 0337-122-F14, PE-101 (Back Gate);
- Railroad grade separation on Hampton Boulevard at International Terminal Boulevard, Project Number 0337-122-F14, PE-102 (Front Gate);
 - 3. I-564 Intermedal Connector, Project Number R000-122-108,PE-101;
- Hampton Roads Third Crossing, Project Number 0064-114-F12, PE-101; and

WHEREAS, there may be future projects by the Virginia Department of Transportation or the United States Department of the Navy as contained in the 1996 report entitled "Virginia Intermodal Partnership," and

WHEREAS, the potential future projects constructed by the Virginia Department of Transportation may also require right of way from the Norfolk Naval Station; and

WHEREAS, there will be a need to comply with the National Environmental Policy Act requirements; and

WHEREAS, there will be a need to mutually cooperate in the development of these projects; and

WHEREAS, to ensure a good faith effort by the Virginia Department of Transportation and the Commander, Navy Region, Mid-Attantic, regarding right of way, environmental and other issues that may arise in the development of said projects, a Memorandum of Understanding between said parties has been prepared to ensure cooperation now and in the future.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED on this 16th day of December, 1999, by the Commonwealth Transportation Board that they hereby authorize the Commissioner of the Virginia Department of Transportation to sign this Memorandum of Understanding with the Commander, Navy Region, Mid-Atlantic.

Moved by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Grubb, that the Board approve the report of the Internal Audit Committee. The Committee met on November 17, 1999. The Internal Audit Division's Organizational Chart, Charter, and Reporting Process were given to the Committee and the responsibilities of the Internal Audit Division and the Internal Audit Committee were discussed. The Audit Plan for 1999-2000 and the FY99 Audit Plan Accomplishments were discussed and copies given to the Committee. The Committee reviewed the report for the audit of the Construction Division and accepted as adequate the actions taken, or to be taken, on the report.

Moved by Mrs. Lignberger, seconded by Mr. Martin, that

WHEREAS, in connection with Route 58, State Highway
Project 6058-070-E20,RW-204, the Commonwealth acquired certain land from
Industrial Development Authority of Patrick County by deed dated June 15, 1999,
recorded in Deed Book 392, Page 238, in the Office of the Clerk of the Circuit Court
of Patrick County; and

WHEREAS, the former property owner had encumbered the land with certain restrictions and covenants prior to the land being purchased by the Industrial Development Authority of Patrick County; and

WHEREAS, these restrictions and covenants were therefore passed on to the future purchasers of the land; and

WHEREAS, the Industrial Development Authority of Patrick County is in the process of releasing these restrictions and covenants so that the land, excluding VDOT right of way, may be developed; and

WHEREAS, the Industrial Development Authority of Petrick County has requested that all purchasers of any portion of the original land join in the execution of a deed of termination of restrictions and reservations; and

WHEREAS, the Commonwealth Transportation Commissioner has certified in writing that the restrictions and covenants encumbering the VDOT right of way are deemed by him no longer necessary for the uses of the State Highway System.

NOW, THEREFORE, in accordance with the provisions of Section 33.1-149 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, the releasing of the restrictions and covenants, so certified, is approved and the Commonwealth Transportation Commissioner is hereby authorized to execute, in the name of the Commonwealth, a deed of termination of restrictions and reservations, releasing the restrictions and covenants for a consideration satisfactory to the Director of Right of Way and Utilities, subject to such restrictions as may be deemed appropriate.

Item 15:

Moved by Mr. Prettyman, seconded by Mrs. Lionberger, that

WHEREAS, Section 33.1-41.1 of the Code of Virginia, as amended, provides that for the purpose of calculating street allocations to the eligible cities and towns, and for making street payments, the Department of Transportation shall divide affected roads and streets into two categories: (1) Principal and Minor Arterial Roads, and (2) Collector and Local Streets; and

WHEREAS, Section 33.1-288 of the Code of Virginia, as amended, provides that the Commonwealth Transportation Board may pay to the Chesapeake Bay Bridge and Tunnel Commission, the same amounts authorized by Section 33.1-41.1; and

WHEREAS, the Department established a State Functional Classification System and an Urban Street Inventory depicting those roads and streets eligible to receive subject street payments; and

WHEREAS, such street payments shall be based on the number of movinglane miles of such roads and streets available to peak-hour traffic in each category in each locality and on the 1986 base per-lane-mile payment rate adjusted by a statewide maintenance cost index; and

WHEREAS, funds allocated by the Board for such street payments shall be paid in equal sums for each quarter of the fiscal year, and

WHEREAS, no payment shall be made without the approval of the Board; and

WHEREAS, the Board approved yearly and quarterly payments for FY 99-00 for each local entity, except that approval of the yearly and quarterly payments to the Chesapeake Bay Bridge and Tunnel Commission was deferred until further action of this Board.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the yearly and quarterly payment to the Chesapeake Bay Bridge and Tunnel Commission are hereby approved.

Item 16:

Moved by Mr. Porter, seconded by Mr. Prettyman, that

WHEREAS, the Commonwealth Transportation Board and the Virginia Department of Transportation have been providing assistance to the City of Franklin during the aftermath of the flooding caused by Humicane Floyd; and

WHEREAS, in response to Governor Gitmore's direction to state agencies to assist the disaster stricken community of Franklin in its recovery, the Board has examined the availability of additional transportation funds to assist the City of Franklin as it continues to rebuild; and

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Board that the City of Franklin does intend to apply for Transportation Enhancement Program funding for eligible projects within the City; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the pressing demands placed upon the City of Franklin's staff throughout the recovery period, the City will not have sufficient time to prepare an application at the level of detail normally required for successful applications; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Commonwealth Transportation Board to assist the City of Franklin during the recovery.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Commonwealth Transportation Board hereby approves an immediate initial Enhancement allocation to the City of Franklin in the amount of \$1,000,000.00, such sum to be made available to the City upon execution of the necessary project agreement. Such sum shall be provided off the top from the fiscal year 2000-01 Enhancement allocation. VDOT and the City shall work together to identify projects eligible for this funding.
